TOP NOTES

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen made 32 saves on 34 shots in tonight's game, which marked the 16th time this season he has made 30 or more saves in a single game.

With his two points (1+1), **Tage Thompson** has now recorded 19 points (10+9) in his last 13 games, including seven goals and 11 points in his last six contests. In his last eight games against Philadelphia, **Thompson** has posted 10 points (7+3). Since March 1, **Thompson** leads all Sabres skaters in points (18) and even-strength points (15).

JJ Peterka notched the primary assist on **Thompson's** goal. **Peterka** has posted 12 points (8+4) in his last 12 games, including seven goals in that span. He has now tallied one assist in three consecutive games against the Flyers

Alex Tuch also collected an assist on **Thompson's** goal. In his last 12 games, **Tuch** has tallied 15 points (3+12), including six points (1+5) in his last four games. Including tonight's game, **Tuch** has registered six points (3+3) in his last four games against the Flyers.

As a result of his goal, **Rasmus Dahlin** has now registered five points (2+3) in his last four games. The goal was his 19th of the season and he has now joined Phil Housley as the only Sabres defensemen to record 19 or more goals in a single season. **Dahlin** is now tied for second among all NHL defensemen in goals in 2023-24. He trails only Roman Josi (20).

Thompson recorded the lone assist on **Dahlin's** goal, which gave him his second point of tonight's game. He is the sixth Sabres skater (**Zach Benson**, **Dylan Cozens**, **Victor Olofsson**, **Peterka**, **Thompson**, **Tuch**) who has registered multiple points in back-to-back games this season.

Jack Quinn's first goal of the game was his first since returning from injury on March 27. He has now recorded at least one point in consecutive games (2+1). It marked the fourth time he has done so this season, and the first since he did so from Jan. 24 to 27 (1+3). His second goal gave him the third multigoal game of his career, and his first since Dec. 4, 2022 vs. San Jose (2+0).

With his second assist of the game on **Quinn's** second goal, **Benson** (0+2, 18 years, 329 days) became the second-youngest Sabres skater to record multiple assists in consecutive games. **Dahlin** (18 years, 247 days) from Dec. 15 to 16, 2018 (1+4) is the youngest Sabres skater who has done so.
