THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Today's game marks the 200th regular-season contest between the Sabres and Flyers in franchise history.

Philadelphia is set to become the seventh team to play in 200 or more games against Buffalo all-time, joining Boston (318), Montreal (300), Toronto (231), Carolina (216), Pittsburgh (214) and the New York Rangers (205).

The Sabres have earned at least one point in five of their last seven road contests against the Flyers (4-2-1).

JJ Peterka has tallied 23 points (12+11) in his last 22 games and he has registered 11 points (5+6) in his last 11 games.

In his last 11 games, **Ryan McLeod** has posted 12 points (3+9) and has collected 14 points (3+11) in his last 12 road games.



Tage Thompson has posted 38 points (20+18) in his last 36 games, including 23 points (14+9) in his last 21.

Tyson Kozak is riding a three-game point streak (2+2) and a point today would extend his career-long point streak to four games.

Peyton Krebs has posted at least one point in back-to-back games and he has tallied three points (1+2) in that span.

Zach Benson has recorded one assist in each of his last two games.

Jack Quinn has recorded one point in two consecutive games and a point today would give him his third three-game point streak this season.

In his last three games, Alex Tuch has posted three points (2+1).

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 7-7-4 all-time on March 29.

March 29, 2004: Martin Biron stops 23 shots to record his 17th career shutout and 100th NHL victory, a 6-0 win vs. Columbus.

<u>March 29, 2006</u>: Daniel Briere registers three assists and Tim Connolly (0+2), Chris Drury (1+1) and J.P. Dumont (2+0) each record multi-point games in a 4-3 win over Boston.

MR. 500

Rasmus Dahlin is expected to play in the 500th game of his career in today's game.

Dahlin (24 years, 350 days) will become the third defenseman in NHL history to reach 500 games played before age 25 (Phil Housley, 24 years, 314 days; Scott Stevens, 24 years, 264 days).

Dahlin has posted 349 points (79+270) through his first 499 games with Buffalo.

HEAD-TO-HEAD

Dahlin is set to become the 33rd Sabres skater, and the 12th Sabres defenseman, to appear in 500 or more games with Buffalo.

Among the 24 Sabres skaters to begin their career with Buffalo and skate in 500 games with the Sabres, **Dahlin** would currently rank fourth in assists, ninth in points and 15th in goals.

Dahlin has registered at least one point in four consecutive games (1+4) and a point today would give him his third point streak of five or more games this season.

An assist today would give him a three-game assist streak.
