THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned a win in three of their last four road contests against the Canadiens and they have outscored Montreal 17-11 in that span.

In the three wins in that span, Buffalo did not allow a single power-play goal.

Rasmus Dahlin has recorded 25 assists in his last 24 games and he has registered 16 points (3+13) in his last 13 games.

Dahlin's 25 assists in that span is tied for first among all NHL skaters.

JJ Peterka has tallied 13 points (7+6) in his last 12 games and he is riding a four-game point streak (2+2).

A point in tonight's game would mark **Peterka's** third point streak of five or more games this season.



Alex Tuch has collected 11 points (6+5) in his last eight games, including six goals in his last six games.

Tuch has registered one goal in three consecutive games and he would match the longest goal streak of his career with a goal in tonight's game.

Tage Thompson has posted 26 points (12+14) in his last 23 games, including 11 points (6+5) in his last eight.

In his last 21 games, Jason Zucker has

recorded 23 points (10+13), including 11 points (3+8) in his last nine games.



ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 9-10-8 all-time on March 3.

March 3, 1977: The Sabres get multi-point efforts from six different players -- led by Bill Hajt's three points (1+2) -- and goals from seven different players in the team's 7-2 win vs. Los Angeles.

March 3, 2006: The Sabres retire Pat LaFontaine's No. 16 jersey and Derek Roy records his first NHL hat trick in a 6-2 win over the Toronto Maple Leafs in Buffalo.

March 3, 2010: Jochen Hecht registers his 400th career NHL point with a goal against Washington.

ROCHING AND ROLLING

The Rochester Americans hold a record of 34-14-6 and they had registered more points than any AHL team (74).

The Amerks are tied with the Laval Rocket for the most wins in the AHL.



Among all Amerks skaters, **Isak Rosen** ranks first in goals (26), points (50) and points per game (0.98).

Rosen's 26 goals are tied for second and his 50 points rank tied for third among all AHL skaters this season.

Devon Levi has recorded 117 saves on 122 shots (.959) in his last four appearances and he has registered a save percentage of .919 and a goals-against average of 2.19 this season.

Levi ranks tied for first among all qualified AHL goaltenders in shutouts (5), tied for third in wins (19), fourth in goals-against average and fifth in save percentage.

Nikita Novikov has registered 18 points (5+13) in 50 games and his plus-26 rating is tied for second among all AHL skaters.

Noah Ostlund has recorded 17 points (8+9) in his last 15 games, including at least one goal in three straight games (3+1).

Konsta Helenius leads all Amerks rookies in assists (17) and points (26).
