AT A GLANCE

STREAKIN' FROM SWEDEN

Forward **Adrian Kempe** (1-1=2) extended the Kings' win streak to a fifth consecutive game by scoring his seventh career overtime goal last night in Winnipeg. The OT marker extended his active goal-streak to a fourth game (4-2=6), matching a career high that he has set three times prior (Last: 4-1=5, Nov. 4, 2023 – Nov. 11, 2023). Earlier in last night's victory, Kempe collected his 19th assist of the season to extend his season-long point-streak to a sixth game (4-4=8) dating back to Dec. 22 at Washington. Kempe now has sole possession of the most overtime goals among Kings skater since the winger made his NHL debut on Feb. 16, 2017, passing defenseman **Drew Doughty** (6) last night at Canada Life Centre. Paired with his game-winning goal (GWG) in regulation against the Tampa Bay Lightning last Saturday in Los Angeles, the forward has now scored back-to-back game-winners for the first time in his career.

KEEPERS OF THE CASTLE

After opening the 2025 calendar year with a 3-0 shutout victory over the New Jersey Devils, the Kings near the midpoint of the 2024-25 season with the stingiest team defense in the NHL. Through their first 39 games of the campaign, the Kings have limited opponents to a League-low 24.9 shots against per game (SA/GP) and the have allowed just 2.46 goals against per game (GA/GP). Across the NHL, the Kings have the fewest goals against overall (96), the fewest goals against in the first period (22), and the fewest goals against per game (2.46). Among all League clubs, the Kings are the only team to have conceded fewer than 100 goals against at this stage of the campaign.
