# **2024-25 SEASON**

- Started the season with SEA, tallying six goals and 17 points in 36 games
- Traded to TBL on March 5 and would play 21 games, posting a goal and 14 points
- Tallied eight points (0-8—8) in his first 11 games with TBL following the trade
- Had a three-game point streak from April 3-7 (0-3—3)
- Dished out 50 hits from March 6 through the end of the season, good for the second-most hits among TBL skaters in that timeframe

# **CAREER**

# 2023-24 Season

- Played in 80 games for SEA, logging 11 goals and 33 points
- Notched his seventh consecutive 30-point season
- Ranked second among SEA skaters for faceoff wins (519) and shorthanded time on ice (152:12)
- Had two assists on January 13 at CBJ, notching his 300th NHL point with his first assist
- Scored two shorthanded goals on April 18 at MIN, becoming first player in SEA history to do so

#### 2022-23 Season

- Appeared in 81 games for SEA, logging 14 goals and 48 points, tied for the second-most points of his career
- Tallied assists in a career-best four consecutive games from November
   1-8 and matched that total from December 11-18
- Played in 14 Stanley Cup Playoff games for SEA
- Posted four goals and nine assists to lead SEA skaters for assists and points
- Scored the first overtime goal of his playoff career in SEA's 5-4 win over DAL in Game 1 of the second round on May 2

# **CAREER CONT.**

#### 2021-22 Season

- Named an Alternate Captain for SEA on October 11
- Played in 74 games for SEA, tallying 21 goals and 48 points
- Ranked second among SEA skaters for assists (27) and points
- Set career highs in faceoff wins (444) and ice time per game (18:29)

#### 2020-21 Season

- Saw action in 56 games with TBL, tallying 17 goals and 36 points
- Led TBL in faceoffs (649) and faceoff wins (316)
- Played in 23 Stanley Cup Playoff games for TBL, logging six goals and seven points
- Scored two game-winning goals, including the series-clinching shorthanded goal in Game 7 of the Eastern Conference Final vs. NYI

#### 2019-20 Season

- Played 70 games for TBL, posting 10 goals and 30 points
- Ranked second on TBL for faceoff win percentage (54.1%)
- Recorded five game-winning goals, good for the fourth-most among TBL skaters
- Played in 25 Stanley Cup Playoff games with TBL, notching seven goals and 14 points to help win the Stanley Cup
- Scored two goals in six Stanley Cup Final games

#### 2018-19 Season

- Skated in 80 games with TBL, recording 22 goals and 48 points
- Ranked fifth among TBL skaters for both goals and points
- Notched his second career 20-goal season
- Ranked fourth on TBL for game-winning goals (5) and power-play goals (4)
- Recorded a season-long six-game point streak from October 11-21 (4-4—8)
- Saw action in all four of TBL's Stanley Cup Playoff games and scored one goal on five shots

#### 2017-18 Season

- Played in all 82 games for TBL in his rookie season, posting 25 goals and 64 points to go along with 50 penalty minutes
- Set the TBL rookie record for goals and points in a season
- Ranked fourth on TBL for goals, assists and points
- Led the team and ranked tied for third in the NHL for plus/minus with a +34 rating
- Ranked third among all NHL rookies for points
- Skated in 17 Stanley Cup Playof games, recording 2 goals and 7 points
- Registered a goal and assist in his playoff debut in Game 1 versus New Jersey
- Notched a point in 4 of 5 second round games against Boston (1-3—4)

#### 2016-17 Season

- Spent the majority of the season with AHL Syracuse, playing 56 games and recording 22 goals and 48 points
- Ranked second on the Crunch for goals and third for points
- Ranked tied for first in the AHL with four shorthanded goals
- Played in 22 Calder Cup Playoff games with Syracuse, logging nine goals and 27 points
- Ranked first on SYR for playoff assists and second for playoff points
- Skated in 20 games with TBL, posting six goals and eight points
- Scored his first career NHL goal on March 11 against FLA
- Scored goals in three consecutive games from March 27-April 1

#### 2015-16 Season

- Saw action in 65 games for AHL Syracuse, tallying 14 goals and 44 points
- Ranked fourth on SYR for points and assists and ranked tied for fourth for goals
- Made his NHL debut on December 15 at TOR and recorded his first NHL point (assist)
- Played two games for TBL, tallying an assist and two penalty minutes

#### 2014-15 Season

- Played in 76 games for SYR and posted 29 goals and 57 points
- Led SYR for goals and power-play goals (8)
- Ranked second for points among SYR skaters
- Was the lone Crunch skater to appear in all of the team's 76 games
- Played in three Calder Cup Playoff games for SYR (1-1—2)

#### 2013-14 Season


- Skated in 43 games split between AHL Worcester and AHL Syracuse
