Schedule Updates

The Boston Bruins practice and media schedule can be found on the Bruins' media website. Any last-minute time changes or updates will be communicated to media by a member of the Bruins communications staff.

Gameday Materials

All gameday materials will be available digitally (e.g. game notes, stats, starting lineups) on the <u>Bruins' media website</u>. Box scores and game sheets will be available on NHL.com.

Audio/Video Share

CREDENTIALS & MEDIA SERVICES

Game-by-Game Credentials

Media interested in receiving access to Boston Bruins home games at TD Garden must request a credential 72 hours prior to the game. Credential requests should be submitted through the <u>credential request form</u> on the <u>Bruins' media website</u>. **Please** note that all media, regardless of their full season credential status must submit a credential request for each home game.

Away Games

Media who wish to cover a Bruins away game must submit a credential request to Annie Kew (akew@bostonbruins.com).

PRACTICE AND MORNING SKATE AT WARRIOR ICE ARENA

Practice Coverage

Media members interested in attending a Bruins practice or morning skate at Warrior Ice Arena should contact Hannah Wolfe (hwolfe@bostonbruins.com) at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled practice start time.

Media Entrance and Work Locations

Media should arrive through the Warrior Ice Arena entrance located at 80 Guest St. Upon arrival, media may report to the Level 4 media workroom and photographers

may proceed to their shooting position on Level 2. Media and photographers may travel to their designated locations via the stairs or the elevators.

Shooting Positions

Still photographers and videographers may set up on Level 2 behind the glass or on the Level 3 concourse. Photographers and videographers can also shoot from the visiting bench if it is not in use. Lights are not permitted behind the glass or on the bench.

Coach/Player Availability and Interviews

Head Coach Jim Montgomery will be available to media in-person in the Bruins video room following practice and morning skate. A member of the Boston Bruins communications staff will escort the entire media contingent at one time from the media work room to Level 2.

Following the video room availability, select players will be available to the media inperson in the Bruins locker room

The Boston Bruins communications staff will work with media to accommodate one-on-one interviews on a case-by-case basis on Bruins practice days. One-on-ones will be facilitated in-person after or during general media access. All one-on-one requests should be made to Travis Basciotta (tbasciotta@bostonbruins.com) and Annie Kew (akew@bostonbruins.com) at least 24 hours in advance.

Warrior Ice Arena Wireless Information

To connect to the private media wireless network at Warrior Ice Arena, media will need to select the "Other..." option underneath the listed wireless networks and manually input the below information:

GAME DAY INFORMATION AT TD GARDEN

Media Entrance and Arrival

The Media Entrance for TD Garden will be at TD Garden back security, located on the East side (Zakim Bridge side) of TD Garden at the far end of Legends Way. From

Causeway Street, walk all the way down Legends Way past the main doors to North Station/TD Garden. After the main entrance, the media entrance will be located on the left with stair and disability ramp access.

The window in which media members may arrive to TD Garden begins no earlier than two and a half hours prior to the scheduled start of the game and concludes at the scheduled start time. For example, for a 7 p.m. game, media may arrive between 4:30 p.m. and 7 p.m. Media arriving after the scheduled start time will not be guaranteed access.

After picking up credentials and going through security, media may take the freight elevator (Elevator 6) to Level 9. Seating charts will be located in visible locations along the media's path of travel. Media members are permitted to stay in the press box and/or the media work room on Level 3 for up to one hour after the conclusion of media availability.

Media Meal

Media Meal will be located in the Will McDonough Press Room (Level 3) and is available for a \$10 cash donation to the Boston Bruins Foundation. Media Meal will be open from two and a half hours in advance of puck drop and will run until the game begins.

Will McDonough Press Room

In addition to hosting Media Meal, the Will McDonough Press Room (Level 3) will be equipped as a workspace for media to use before, during and after the game. The Bruins postgame press conferences will also be hosted in the Will McDonough Press Room.

Visiting Team Pregame Skate

Media interested in attending the visiting team pregame skate should contact Hannah Wolfe (hwolfe@bostonbruins.com) at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled pregame skate. For access to the visiting teams' morning media availability, media should contact the visiting team's communications staff.

Media Parking

Paid parking is available at the North Station garage.

Bag and X-Ray Screening Policy

All media bags will be searched and tagged upon entry. Color-coded and date stamped tags will be placed on all media bags allowed into the arena. All guests will be subject to an X-Ray screening upon entrance to the building.

Live Shots

Media will be permitted to conduct live shots anywhere outside of TD Garden, or at assigned live shot locations inside TD Garden. Individuals conducting a live shot prior to the game must conclude filming 31 minutes prior to scheduled start time (e.g. for a 7 p.m. game, filming must

Reporters who wish to watch the game from Level 9 must request a seat in the press box at least 72 hours in advance. Media conducting live shots postgame may remain at TD Garden for up to one hour following the conclusion of postgame media availability.

Photography

All photo positions will be assigned prior to the game. Freelance photographers will not receive credentials; all photographers must be on assignment. Editors interested in sending a photographer should request access to Hannah Wolfe (hwolfe@bostonbruins.com) 72 hours prior to the game.

Postgame Home Team Media Availability

Following Bruins games at TD Garden, Head Coach Jim Montgomery will hold a press conference in the Will McDonough Press Room on Level 3. Due to limited space in Elevator 4, media are encouraged to head to the media work room on Level 3 as early as possible to ensure arrival in time for the postgame media availability.

Following the press conference, the Bruins locker room will open and players will be made available to the media.

Media are permitted to work from the media work room or their designated seat on Level 9 for up to one hour after the conclusion of coach and player availability.

Postgame Visiting Team Media Availability

Following Bruins games at TD Garden, the visiting team will have the option to make their coach and select players available in-person. For path of travel to the visiting team's hallway, media should take the freight elevator or elevator 4 from Level 9 to Level 3. Once on Level 3, media will turn to the right and walk around the arena, past the Putnam club, where a hallway leads to the visiting team hallway.

Media are encouraged to contact the visiting team's communications staff with any questions regarding their media availabilities.

PRACTICE AND MORNING SKATE INFORMATION AT TD GARDEN

Practices and morning skates at TD Garden will follow the same guidelines as games at TD Garden. Please see the above policies for any questions regarding arrival and seat locations.
