AT A GLANCE

JUICE IS LOOSE

After scoring both his eighth and ninth goals of the season on Saturday against the Red Wings, forward Adrian Kempe gears up for tomorrow's contest on his fourth career multi-goal streak (Last: 2GP Jan. 3, 2023 – Feb. 11, 2023: 6-0=0). Kempe's quartet of multi-goal stretches account for four of the Kings' seven such streaks in the past decade. The only Kings skater to record a longer multi-goal streak in the 21st century was **Alex Frolov**, who posted a three-game run from Nov. 13, 2006 – Nov. 18, 2006 (6-2=8). Through the team's first 19 games of the season, Kempe's 18 points (9-9=18) are the second most on the Kings behind only Anze Kopitar (5-16=21). The forward enters tonight's matchup with Buffalo as the owner of five points (2-3=5) in the teams' four most recent meetings, dating back to Feb. 13, 2023. Kempe has recorded two points in each of the Sabres' three visits to Crypto.com Arena since the 2020-21 season.

1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8...WE WANT MOORE

Trevor Moore carries a career-long eight-game point streak (2-8=10) into tomorrow's matchup after notching his 10th helper of the year last Saturday. By doing so, Moore became the fourth Kings skater in the last five years to establish a point streak of at least eight games: (Adrian Kempe, 9 GP in 2023-24; Alex lafallo, 9 GP in 2019-20; Kevin Fiala, 8 GP in 2023-24). As part of his eight-game run, Moore recorded his 99th and 100th assists as an LA King last Wednesday, marking his 38th career multi-point performance. He is the eighth U.S.-born skater to record 100 helpers for the franchise and just the 12th undrafted skater to do so.

HATS OFF TO THE CAP

When the Sabres and Kings faced off against one another in this year's season-opener on Oct. 10, Anze Kopitar registered his seventh career hat trick to surpass Wayne Gretzky and Dustin Brown for sole possession of the sixth-most in Kings history. Per NHL PR, with his trio of goals, Kopitar became the fifth player in league history to score a hat trick in two season-opening games (also 3-2=5 on Oct. 14, 2021). The others: Auston Matthews (3-0=3 on Oct. 11, 2023 & 4-0=4 on Oct. 12, 2016), Connor McDavid (3-1=4 on Oct. 12, 2022 & 3-0=3 on Oct. 4, 2017), Brendan Shanahan (3-0=3 on Oct. 4, 2001 & 3-0=3 on Oct. 7, 1993) and Cam **Neely** (3-0=3 on Oct. 7, 1995 & 3-0=3 on Jan. 22, 1995).
