- **Tyler Seguin** went a perfect 6-for-6 at the faceoff dot. It marked the first time in his career that he has taken at least six faceoffs in a game without losing any of them.

GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the first game the Stars will play against the Penguins this season. The two teams will next face off on Saturday, April 5 in Dallas.
- The Stars are 5-1-0 against the Penguins since the start of the 2021-22 season, outscoring Pittsburgh 16-10 in those contests.
 - The Stars have not allowed more than two goals in any of those six games.
 - Their .833 points percentage against Pittsburgh since the start of 2021-22 is the second-best mark in the league.
- Dallas has also gone 12-for-13 on the penalty kill against Pittsburgh since the start of the 2021-22 season. Their 92.3 percent success rate while playing a man down against the Penguins is the fourth-best mark of any team during that span.
- Stars assistant coach **Alain Nasreddine** played for the Penguins for parts of three seasons (2005-06 to 2007-08), appearing in 56 regular-season games.
- The Stars have allowed only 2.46 goals against per game this season, which was the third-best mark in the NHL in the NHL entering play Sunday.
- **Jamie Benn** has gone 67-for-103 at the faceoff dot this season. His 65.1 percent success rate is the second-best mark in the NHL this year among skaters to take at least 100 draws entering play Sunday.
- **Esa Lindell** is averaging 3:45 of shorthanded time on ice per game this season, which was the sixth-highest mark in the NHL entering play Sunday.
- Entering play Sunday, **Casey DeSmith** ranked in the top 10 in the NHL in both goals-against average (1.79, third) and save percentage (.929, sixth) this season.
- Stars head coach **Pete DeBoer** is one victory away from recording the 621st win of his career, which will give him sole possession of 20th on the all-time head coaching wins list.

MARCH OF THE PENGUINS

- **Jamie Benn** enters tonight's game riding a three-game point streak against the Penguins, scoring three goals and adding an assist in those games.
- **Matt Duchene** has five points (2-3-5) in this last five games he has played against the Penguins in Pittsburgh.

- **Thomas Harley** has three points (1-2—3) in two career games against Pittsburgh and has tallied at least a point in each of the two games he has played against the Penguins.
- **Jake Oettinger** has a 4-1-0 career record against the Penguins, posting a .943 save percentage and a 1.81 goals-against average in those games.
 - **Oettinger's** 1.81 goals-against average ranks sixth among netminders to play the Penguins at least three times since the start of the 2020-21 season.
- **Jason Robertson** has nine points (1-8—9) in five career games against Pittsburgh. He has posted multi-point efforts in four of the five games he has played against the Penguins.
 - **Robertson's** 1.80 points per game against the Penguins since the start of the 2020-21 season is the second-highest rate in the NHL amongst players to have played Pittsburgh at least twice, trailing only Edmonton's Connor McDavid (2.43).

CASE BY CASE BASIS

- **Casey DeSmith** has posted a 1.79 goals-against average and a .929 save percentage in five games with the Stars this season. Entering play Sunday, he ranked in the top 10 in the NHL in both goals-against average (third) and save percentage (sixth) this year.
- **DeSmith** has saved 5.3 goals above expected this season according to MoneyPuck.com, which ranked 10th among NHL netminders entering play Sunday.
- **DeSmith** has also saved 1.19 goals above expected per 60 this year according to MoneyPuck.com, which was the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Sunday. Only New York's Jonathan Quick (1.84) and Carolina's Frederik Andersen (1.76) ranked higher.
- **DeSmith** previously played for the Penguins, signing with the team as a free agent on July 1, 2017. He went on to play for Pittsburgh for five season (2017-18 to 2022-23), posting a 58-44-15 record with a 2.81 goals-against average, .912 save percentage and nine shutouts in 134 regular-season games.
- If he plays, tonight will mark **DeSmith's** first game against his former team.

TYLER THE CREATOR

- **Tyler Seguin** has recorded a point in seven of the nine games that he has played this year (6-4—10) and enters tonight's matchup against the Penguins ranked third on the team in scoring.
- **Seguin's** 10 points through his first nine games played of the season is his highest scoring rate to begin a year since he had 11 points (3-8—11) in the first nine games he played in 2018-19.
- With six goals and 10 points in nine games, **Seguin** is playing at a 52-goal and 89-point pace.
- When **Seguin** has been on the ice this year during 5-on-5 play, the Stars have outscored their opponents 5-2 according to Natural Stat Trick.

DOUBLE DUTCH

- **Matt Duchene** enters tonight's game having totaled 15 points (7-8—15) in 13 games this season, which includes recording five multi-point efforts this year.
- 2024-25 marks the first time in **Duchene's** career that he has had 15 or more points through his first 13 games played of a season.
- **Duchene** has recorded a point in nine of the 13 games he has played this season and enters tonight's game leading the Stars in both goals (seven) and points (15). Only **Logan Stankoven** (10) has more assists than **Duchene** this season.
- When **Duchene** has been on the ice this season during 5-on-5 play, the Stars have outscored their opponents 8-4 according to Natural Stat Trick.
- **Duchene** was named the NHL's Third Star of the Week for the week ending on Oct. 27 after totaling six points (3-3—6) in three games, a stretch that included a three-point performance (1-2—3) against Boston.
- He is currently pacing to finish the year with 45 goals, 50 assists and 95 points, which would all be career highs for the 16-year veteran.

ROOKIE REPORT

- **Logan Stankoven** has 12 points (2-10—12) through his first 13 games played this season and enters tonight's game leading the Stars in assists and ranked second on the team in scoring.
- Entering play Friday, **Stankoven** was leading all rookies in assists and points this season. His 0.92 points per game this season was the highest mark of any first-year player to appear in at least four games this season.
- **Stankoven** recorded his 10th assist of the season (12 GP) in Dallas' game on Nov. 7 against Chicago, establishing a franchise mark for fewest games to 10 helpers in a season by a Stars/North Stars rookie according to NHL Stats. The previous mark of 14 games was shared by Don Barber (1989-90 w/ MNS), Tim Young (1975-76 w/ MNS) and Danny O'Shea (1968-69 w/ MNS).
- **Stankoven** (8-18—26 in 36 GP) added an empty-net goal against Chicago to become the second-fastest player in Stars team history to record 25 career points, following **Jason Robertson** (33 GP) according to NHL Stats.
- With his assist on Oct. 15 against the Sharks, **Stakoven** became just the second rookie in Stars/North Stars history to record five or more assists through his first four games of a season, joining Marc Bureau (5 in 4 GP in 1990-91) according to NHL Stats.

- He recorded three assists in Dallas' 4-3 win over the Predators on Oct. 10, making him the only rookie to have a three-point game this season.
- According to NHL Stats, **Stankoven** became the second rookie in franchise history to record three points in the team's season-opening contest, alongside Roland Eriksson (0-4—4 w/ MNS) on Oct. 6, 1976.
- Originally selected by the Stars in the second round (47th overall) of the 2021 NHL Draft, **Stankoven** appeared in 24 regular-season games for Dallas last year, totaling 14 points (6-8—14) in those contests and adding eight points (3-5—8) in 19 Stanley Cup Playoff games.
- His 10 assists this season have already surpassed his total from last year and he is two points shy of matching his total from 2023-24.
- **Stankoven** is pacing to finish the year with 63 assists and 76 points. Sixty-three assists would establish a franchise record for assists by a Stars/North Stars rookie and 76 points would make him the second-highest scoring rookie in franchise history (Neal Broten, 100 points).

BENN THERE DONE THAT

- Stars captain **Jamie Benn** enters tonight's contest having played in 310 consecutive games.
- Dallas' Oct. 13 matchup against the Kraken marked the 300th consecutive game that **Benn** had played in, making him the fourth player in franchise history to play in 300 consecutive games for the team according to NHL Stats.

- **Benn's** current 310-game Iron Man streak is the fifth-longest active streak in the NHL.
- **Benn** is one of 16 players to have an active Iron Man streak of at least 200 games and is one of 11 NHL players to appear in each of his team's 246 regular-season games between 2021-22 and 2023-24.
- The Stars captain leads all Dallas players in career games played (1,125), goals (386), assists (527) and points (913). His 913 career points rank 13th among active NHL skaters, and he is the second-highest scoring fifth-round draft pick in NHL history (Alexander Mogilny; 1,032).

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- **Esa Lindell** has several franchise milestones withing reach:
 - He is six points shy of becoming the 49th player and 13th defenseman in franchise history to record 200 points with the Stars.
 - **Lindell** is two goals away from tying Philippe Boucher for 10th in franchise history in goals scored by a defenseman.
 - He is also 18 games shy of tying Lou Nanne (635) for ninth on the franchise's all-time games played list by defensemen.
- **Tyler Seguin** is four assists away from bringing his total with the stars to 380, which would tie him with Brian Bellows for fifth-most assists by a skater in franchise history.
- **Jake Oettinger's** next shutout will be the 12th of his career, which will tie Jon Casey for the sixth-most in franchise history.
- **Miro Heiskanen** is seven assists shy of tying Dennis Hextall (216) for 23rd on the franchise's all-time assists list. He's also eight assists shy of trying Brad Maxwell (217) for 7th on the all-time assists list by defensemen.
