GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the final of two games the Stars will play against the Flyers this season and the first time that they have played in Dallas this year.
 - o Dallas defeated Philadelphia with a 4-1 win on Jan. 9.
- The Stars enter tonight's game with a 43-21-4 record for 90 points and a .662 points percentage. Their point total, points percentage and 43 wins ranked third in the NHL this season entering play Friday.
- Jamie Benn enters tonight's game one goal shy of scoring his 400th career goal. When he reaches the milestone, he
 will become...
 - o The second player in franchise history to score 400 goals, joining Mike Modano (557). 438 of Modano's 557 goals were scored with the Star after the team relocated to Dallas.
 - o The second player drafted in 2007 to score 400 goals, with the other being Detroit's Patrick Kane (485).
 - The 10th active skater to score 400 career goals.
- Entering play Friday, the Stars were the only team this season to have not lost more than two consecutive games.
- Entering play Friday, the Stars ranked in the top five in the NHL this season in goals for per game (3.37, fourth) and top 10 in goals against per game (2.62, sixth).
 - o Dallas has allowed two or fewer goals in 33 of the 68 games that they have played this year.

FLYERS FLY AWAY

Dallas is 52-74-35 all-time vs. Philadelphia, including a 36-25-18 mark on home ice.

- Dallas has won eight of their last 10 games vs. Philadelphia dating back to Jan. 10, 2019. The Stars have also won their last seven contests at American Airlines Center dating to Dec. 11, 2015.
- Jason Robertson has nine points (3-6—9) in seven career games against the Flyers. He has recorded a point in six of those seven games.
- Matt Duchene has totaled 19 points (10-9—19) in 23 career games vs. Philadelphia. He has also recorded seven points (4-3—7) in 11 home games against the Flyers.
 - o Duchene enters today's tilt have recorded eight points (3-5-8) in his last nine games against Philadelphia.
- Wyatt Johnston has five points (2-3—5) in five career games played against the Flyers.
- Roope Hintz has nine points (5-4-9) in nine career games vs. Philadelphia.
- Mikko Rantanen has recorded 17 points (10-7—17) in 16 career games against the Flyers. He enters today's matchup
 having four points (2-2—4) in his last two games.
- Mikael Granlund enters today's contest totaling six points (2-4—6) in his last six games vs. Philadelphia. In all, Granlund has 16 points (5-11—16) in 21 career games against the Flyers.
- **Jake Oettinger** is 3-1-0 with a 2.00 goals-against average and .940 save percentage in four career appearances vs. Philadelphia.

IT'S NOT OVER 'TIL IT'S OVER

- Each of the Stars last three games have gone beyond regulation, with the Stars coming from behind in each game to force overtime. It marks the first time since Dec. 16 to 21, 2023 that the Stars have played three overtime games.
- If today's game requires extra time, it will mark the first time that the Stars have played four consecutive overtime games since Jan. 23 to Feb. 6, 2023. They posted a 3-1 record in those games.
- In all this season, the Stars have a 6-2 record in games that have ended in overtime, which is tied for the ninth-most overtime wins in the NHL this season. Their .750 win percentage in games that end in overtime was tied for the third-best mark in the NHL this season entering play Friday, trailing only the Colorado Avalanche, who have gone 5-1 (0.833), and the Toronto Maple Leafs who have gone 7-2 (0.778).
- All six of Dallas' overtime, game-winning goals have been scored by different skaters: Matt Duchene on Dec. 14 vs. St.
 Louis, Thomas Harley on Jan. 4 vs. Utah, Jamie Benn on Jan. 7 vs. NY Rangers, Jason Robertson on March 6 vs. Calgary
 and Mikael Granlund on March 18 vs. Anaheim.
- Entering play Friday, Dallas, Edmonton (7) and Winnipeg (7) were the only NHL teams to have at least six different skaters score an overtime goal this season.
- Additionally, Robertson has scored three shootout goals this season, which was tied for the most in the NHL this year
 entering play Friday.

HOME COOKING

- The Stars have a 25-7-2 record at home this season. Entering play Friday, they ranked in the top five in the NHL in home wins (tied second), points (tied fourth) and points percentage (.765, fourth).
 - o Dallas' 25 home wins are just one shy of matching their total of 26 from all of last season.
 - o The Stars have earned at least a point in each of the last nine games that he has played at home dating back to Jan. 24 against Vegas.
- The Stars are currently on pace to finish the season with 30 homes wins, which would set a franchise record. The team's 29 home victories in 1989-99 are currently the most in a single season in franchise history.
- Since Jan. 24, the Stars have gone 12-for-26 on the power play at the American Airlines Center. Their 46.2 percent success rate on the power play at home was the best mark in the NHL during that span, and their 12 home power-play goals were tied for second entering play Friday.
- Jason Robertson (38 points, 34 games played), Roope Hintz (36 points 32 games played) and Wyatt Johnston (34 points, 34 games played) are all playing at a point-per-game pace at home this year.
 - o Robertson's 38 home points this year are the most of any Stars skater this season.
- Hintz has scored 18 goals at the American Airlines Center this season, which was tied for the 11th-most home goals in the NHL entering play Friday.
- Thomas Harley has recorded 16 points (4-12—16) in his last 15 home games dating back to Dec. 31. His 16 home points during that span were tied for fourth among all NHL defensemen entering play Friday.
 - o Eleven of those 16 points have come in the seven home games that he has played since Feb. 2
 - He has 24 home points (6-18—24) in all this season, which was tied for 12th-most in among NHL defensemen entering play Friday.
- Matt Duchene has tallied 15 points (3-12—15) in his last 14 home games and enters today's game riding a three-game home point streak.
- Jake Oettinger has won the last six games that he has played at the American Airlines Center dating back to Jan. 24, posting a .909 save percentage and a 2.62 goals-against average in those games.
- Casey DeSmith has a 4-1-1 record at home this year, which includes earning at least a point in his last four starts at the American Airlines Center.

FROM START TO FINNISH

- Prior to the 2025 NHL Trade Deadline, the Stars acquired forward Mikko Rantanen from the Carolina Hurricanes in exchange for forward Logan Stankoven, a 2026 first-round pick, a 2026 third-round pick, a 2027 third-round pick and a 2028 first-round pick. Once the trade was completed, Rantanen signed an eight-year, \$96 million extension with the
- Rantanen, who averaged 1.13 points per game in 2024-25 at the time of the trade, was scoring at the highest rate of any player dealt on the NHL trade deadline since Joe Juneau (1.14) in 1994 according to Sportsnet Stats.
- Rantanen scored a goal and added an assist in his first game with Dallas on March 8 at Edmonton, making him the fifth player in the past 10 years to record multiple points in their Stars debut according to NHL Stats. The others are Marchment (2-0-2 on Oct. 13, 2022), Mats Zuccarello (1-1-2 on Feb. 24, 2019), Connor Carrick (0-2-2 on Oct. 4, 2018) and Adam Cracknell (1-1-2 on Oct. 13, 2016).
- Rantanen's goal was also his 250th career power-play point. He became the seventh Finnish player in NHL history to reach the mark according to NHL Stats, behind Teemu Selanne (588), Jari Kurri (395), Kimmo Timonen (332), Saku Koivu (290), Teppo Numminen (274) and Mikko Koivu (251).
- Rantanen scored again in his second game with the Stars, becoming the sixth player in Stars team history to score in each of their first two games with the club according to NHL Stats. He joined Pelle Eklund in 1993-94, Lane MacDermid in 2012-13, Brett Ritchie in 2014-15, Mattias Janmark in 2015-16 and Marchement in 2022-23.
- Rantanen tallied the 400th assist of his career in Dallas' game on March 16 against Colorado. He became the 46th active skater and third player from the 2015 draft class (Connor McDavid, Mitch Marner) to record 400 NHL assists.
- Rantanen also become the 10th Finnish player in NHL history to record 400 career assists. He required the third-fewest games (636) to reach the mark behind Jari Kurri (523 GP) and Teemu Selanne (603 GP) according to NHL Stats.
- Entering play Friday, Rantanen was tied for 15th in the NHL in scoring this season with 74 points (29-45-74) in 68 regular-season games with the Colorado Avalanche, Carolina Hurricanes and Stars. His assist and point totals top all Stars skaters this season.
- Rantanen's next goal will be his 30th of the season, which will make him the third Finnish player in NHL history to record five straight 30-goal seasons according to NHL Stats, following Jari Kurri (10 from 1980-81 - 1989-90) and Teemu Selanne (6 from 1995-96 - 2000-01).
- Rantanen has totaled 691 points (291-400-691) in 638 regular-season games. Among Finnish-born players in NHL history, he ranks fourth in goals (291), seventh in points (691) and 10th in assists (400).
 - Rantanen is now one of five Finnish players on Dallas' roster, joining Mikael Granlund, Miro Heiskanen, Roope Hintz and Esa Lindell.

CAREER YEARS ARE NEAR

With 14 games remaining in the 2024-25 regular-season, several Stars players are withing striking distance of setting or matching various career highs.

POWER UP

- Since Jan. 1, the Stars have gone 28-for-83 on the power play for a 33.7 percent success rate, which was the secondbest mark in the NHL during that span (Vegas; 33.8) entering play Friday.
- The team's 28 power-play goals since Jan. 1 were the second-most in the NHL entering play Friday, trailing only the Detroit Red Wings (30) for the league lead.

- Wyatt Johnston has scored seven power-play goals since Jan. 1, which was tied for the second-most in the NHL during that span entering play Friday, trailing only Edmonton's Leon Draisaitl (8).
 - o In all this season, **Johnston** has scored a career-high nine power-play goals, which is six more than he had in both 2022-23 and 2023-24.
- The Stars went a perfect 4-for-4 on the power play in their game on March 2 against the Blues, marking the first time that they have scored four power-play goals in a game since Nov. 12, 2023.
 - Dallas' game against St. Louis marked one of four instances this year in which a team has scored four powerplay goals in a game. The Ottawa Senators (10/14 vs. LAK), Winnipeg Jets (10/18 vs. SJS) and Florida Panthers (12/5 at PHI) all previously did so.
- Their performance against the Blues also was the first time in Stars team history that the team had a 100 percent success rate on the power play in a single game while scoring at least four power-play goals.

BISCH BETTER HAVE MY MONEY

- Stars rookie Lian Bichsel has played in 17 games for Dallas since being recalled from Texas (AHL) on Jan. 23. In those games, the Stars have outshot their opponents 116-104 and have 112 scoring chances to their 96 when Bichsel has been on the ice during 5-on-5 play according to Natural Stat Trick.
 - His 52.7 shots for percentage tops all Stars skaters during that span.
- Bichsel has recorded at least four hits in 14 of the 17 games that he has played since being recalled from Texas (AHL). In all this season, he is averaging 17.3 hits per 60, which tops the Stars roster and ranked sixth among all NHL rookies this season to play in at least five games entering play Friday.
- Despite only playing in 25 games this season, **Bichsel** leads all Stars skaters with 107 hits. His 107 hits ranked seventh among all NHL rookies this season entering play Friday.
 - He is the only player rookie to record 100 hits this season to have played in fewer than 30 games this year.
- There have been 10 instances of a Stars skater recording at least six hits in a single game this season, with **Bichsel** owning nine of them.
- **Bichsel** is the only rookie this season to have recorded at least six hits in a game eight times. No other rookie had done it more than four times this season entering play Friday.
- **Bichsel** is the first Stars skater to have at least six hits in a game nine times in a single season since Jani Hakanpää did so in 2022-23.
 - o If he were to have at least six hits in one more game this season, he would become the first Stars skater to have at least six hits in 10 games since Hakanpää did so in 2021-22.

A TALE OF TWO SEASONS

- Prior to Dec. 1, the Stars had a 14-8-0 record for 28 points and a 0.636 points percentage. Their 0.636 points percentage was the seventh best mark in the NHL during that span.
- Since Dec. 1, the Stars have posted a 29-13-4 record in 45 games for 62 points and a 0.674 points percentage. The team's win total during that span was tied for the second-most the NHL entering play Friday and their point total and points percentage ranked third and fourth, respectively.
- Special teams have also been a point of improvement for the Stars since Dec. 1. Prior to the start of December, the Stars
 power play was clicking at an 18.6 percent success rate and the team was killing off 81.5 percent of the penalties they
 took. Since Dec. 1, the Stars have a 25.2 percent and 86.0 percent success rate on the power play and penalty kill,
 respectively.
- Several Stars skaters have also seen significant spikes in their offensive production:

Robertson (tied seventh) and Johnston (tied 11th) both ranked in the top 15 in the NHL in scoring since Dec. 1 entering play Friday.

BIKER GANG

- Thomas Harley has 19 points (6-13—19) in his last 18 games played dating back to Jan. 31, which ranks fifth on Dallas' roster during that span.
- Harley's 19 points since Jan. 31 were the second-most during that span among all NHL defensemen entering play Friday, trailing only Colorado's Cale Makar (25).
- Since Jan. 31 Dallas' first game without Miro Heiskanen Harley has been averaging 25:36 of ice time per game, which tops all Stars skaters and ranked fourth in the NHL entering play Friday.
 - o Prior to Jan. 31, **Harley** was averaging 22:27 of ice time per game.
 - Harley skated a career-high 31:11 in Dallas' last game on March 20 against the Tampa Bay Lightning. It was the highest time on ice total by a Stars skater in a regular-season game since Heiskanen skated 32:01 on April 11, 2021 against the Nashville Predators.
- In all, Harley has totaled 42 points (13-29-42) in 66 regular-season games this season, which puts him on pace to finish the 2024-25 regular season with a career-high 16 goals, 35 assists and 51 points.
 - His 13 goals this season were tied for the seventh-most among all NHL defensemen this season entering play
- Harley enters today's game five points shy of totaling 100 career points. He will become the third defenseman drafted in 2019 to reach the 100-point milestone, joining Detroit's Moritz Seider and Buffalo's Bowen Byram.
- Harley matched his single-game career high with three points (1-2-3) in Dallas' March 18 game against the Ducks, surpassing Larry Murphy (93) for the 25th-most points by a defenseman in team history.
 - In that game, the Stars outshot the Ducks 15-2 when Harley was on the ice during 5-on-5 play according to Natural Stat Trick.

GOALIE GANG

- Jake Oettinger has an 15-6-2 record in his last 23 games played dating back to Dec. 29, posting a .905 save percentage and a 2.68 goals-against average during that span.
 - His 15 wins since Dec. 29 were the fifth-most in the NHL entering play Friday.
- Oettinger earned his 30th win of the season in Dallas' game on March 6, a 3-2 overtime win over the Calgary Flames. According to NHL Stats, he became the fourth goaltender in Stars/North Stars history with four or more 30-win seasons, joining Marty Turco (6x), Ed Belfour (4x) and Kari Lehtonen (4x). He also joined Turco (6 from 2002-03 to 2008-09) and Belfour (4 from 1997-98 to 2000-01) as the only netminders to do so in four consecutive campaigns with the franchise.
- Oettinger made a season-high 39 saves in Dallas' March 2 game, a 6-3 win over the Blues. The Stars were outshot 42-21 in that game.
- Casey DeSmith has posted a 6-0-1 record in his last seven games played dating back to Jan. 25 against the St. Louis Blues, posting a .934 save percentage and a 1.98 goals-against average in those contests.
 - Among netminders that have played at least five games since Jan. 25, DeSmith was tied for fourth and ranked seventh, respectively, in save percentage and goals-against average.
- In all, Oettinger and DeSmith have combined for a .905 save percentage this season, which was the fifth-best mark of any team in the NHL this season entering play Friday. The duo's 2.59 goals-against average this season was also tied for fifth in the NHL this year entering play Friday.

KILLING IT

- The Stars have had an 84.4 percent success rate on the penalty kill this season, which was the second-best mark in the NHL this year entering play Friday (Carolina; 84.8).
- No team in the league this season has allowed fewer power-play goals against than the Stars' 28, and their -22 goal differential on the penalty kill this year was the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Friday.
- If the Stars maintain this pace, it would make the 2024-25 season their best on the penalty kill since 2007-08, when the team finished the season with an 85.6 percent success rate on the penalty kill.
- The Stars are also one of the least-penalized teams in the league, ranking 30th in the league in total penalty minutes (446) and 29th in penalty minutes per game (6:33) entering play Friday.
- Entering play Friday, Esa Lindell was leading all NHL skaters in both total shorthanded ice time (229:55) and shorthanded ice time per game (3:23) this season.
- Among players that have played at least 100 minutes on the penalty kill this season, Thomas Harley and Sam Steel both ranked in the top 10 in the NHL in power-play goals against entering play Friday.
 - o Harley, who has played 106:56 of shorthanded ice time, ranked seventh with 3.93.

 Steel tied for 10th with 4.41. He has totaled 122:27 of shorthanded ice time and is averaging 1:51 of shorthanded ice time per game, both of which top all Dallas forwards this season.

IRON SHARPENS IRON

- The Stars have four skaters that have played in at least 200 consecutive games: Jamie Benn (365), Jason Robertson (278), Esa Lindell (238) and Wyatt Johnston (232). Entering play Friday, Dallas was the only team in the NHL to have four players riding Iron Man streaks of at least 200 games.
- Dallas' last game on March 20 against the Lightning was the 364th consecutive game that Benn played in, which is the
 fifth-longest active Iron Man streak in the NHL.
- Robertson's 278-game Iron Man streak is the 10th-longest in the NHL. The Stars and the Detroit Red Wings were the
 only teams to have two players ranked in the top 10 entering play Friday.
- Lindell's 238-game Iron Man streak ranks seventh among all NHL defensemen.
- Johnston's Iron Man Streak began when he made his NHL debut on Oct. 13, 2022. He is one of 44 players in NHL history to begin their NHL career by playing in at least 200 consecutive games according to NHL Stats.

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- Jake Oettinger's next shutout will be the 12th of his career, which will tie Jon Casey for the sixth-most in franchise history.
- Thomas Harley is five assists shy of tying Gary Sargen (71) for 25th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.
- Roope Hintz is four goals shy of tying Danny Grant (176) for 15th-most goals in franchise history.
- Esa Lindell is six assists shy of tying Stephane Robidas (165) for 10th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.
- Esa Lindell is 13 points shy of tying Lou Nanne (225) for 10th most points by a defenseman in franchise history.
- Jason Robertson is six assists shy of surpassing Miro Heiskanen (225) the 20th-most assists in franchise history.
