### TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets won their fourth-straight game and for the sixth time in the past seven contests with tonight's 3-2 victory.
- ★ Columbus' seven wins through the first 11 games of the season are tied for the most in franchise history (5x, MR: 2021-22) and the 14 points are tied for the second-most, trailing only 2007-08 (15 pts.).
- ★ The Jackets picked up their fifth-straight win over St. Louis in the all-time series dating back to 2023-24 (5-0-0). The club has earned points in 14 of the last 21 meetings since 2014-15 (12-7-2).
- ★ CBJ have also earned points in 10 of the last 13 games in the series at Nationwide Arena (9-3-1).
- ★ The Blue Jackets scored in all three periods for the fourth-straight game and fifth time this season tonight. The team has scored in 25-of-the-33 periods played in regulation in 2025-26.
- ★ Columbus posted 17 shots on goal in the first period tonight, the most in one period during 2025-26 (prev: 16, 2x).

### PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C **Charlie Coyle** (2-7-9, 11 GP) opened the scoring and has picked up points in two-straight games (1-4-5) and five of the past seven (2-6-8). He improved to 6-17-23 in 41 career games against the Blues with 1-1-2 in his last two matchups.

- ★ **G Jet Greaves** (3-3-0, 6 GP) registered his second-straight win on the season as well as third victory against the Blues in his career (3 GP, 109-of-114, .956 SV%, 1.66 GAA).
- ★ **D Denton Mateychuk** (2-2-4, 11 GP) recorded an assist for his first point since Oct. 24.
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** (5-6-11, 11 GP) collected an assist to set a new career high with assists in four-straight contests (0-4-4; previous best: 3 GP – 5x (MR: Feb. 2-22, 2025, 2-3-5)). He improved to 2-3-5 in six career games against the Blues, with points in three-straight outings (1-2-3).
- ★ **C Sean Monahan** (1-4-5, 11 GP) scored his first goal of the season for his 600<sup>th</sup> career NHL point (264-336-600, 829 GP). He becomes the fourth player from the 2013 NHL Draft class to reach 600 points, joining Nathan MacKinnon (1,033), Aleksander Barkov (782) and Elias Lindholm (613). He improved his career mark to 10-10-20 in 28 matchups against St. Louis, and has points in each of his last five contests (2-6-8). He has totaled 7-6-13 in 15 games played on home ice against the club with points in each of his past five home contests (5-4-9).
- ★ **D Ivan Provorov** (2-3-5, 11 GP) notched an assist for points in back-to-back outings (1-1-2).
- ★ **LW Cole Sillinger** (2-4-6, 11 GP) assisted on Coyle's goal for 2-2-4 in back-to-back games and 2-3-5 in his last four.
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** (4-6-10, 11 GP) notched his third consecutive game with a 1-1-2 multi-point effort (3-3-6) and tied his career-high goal scoring streak in the process (3 GP – 3x). The 1-1-2 night marked his 83<sup>rd</sup> career multi-point effort to surpass Boone Jenner for the second-most in franchise history. He improved to 3-7-10 in 16 career outings against St. Louis with 1-4-5 in his last four matchups.
