SKATE FOR LA STRONG

On Feb. 12, the LA Kings, in partnership with the NHL, announced the participant and appearance list for Skate For LA Strong, “A Celebration to Support the Fire Recovery Efforts in Los Angeles.” Taking place at Crypto.com Arena on Sunday, Feb. 23 at 3:00 p.m. PST, the event will be highlighted by a hockey exhibition featuring celebrities, NHL alumni and local first responders, as well as special musical performances. Entertainment icons **Danny Devito**, **Will Ferrell**, and **Vince Vaughn** headline the attendees and will be serving in various roles at the event, including honorary coaches and broadcasters. Forward **Adrian Kempe** swaps the Tre Kronor for a Kings' crown in tomorrow's return to regular season competition with 25 goals and 46 points (25-21=46) this season, pacing all Kings skaters in both categories.
