### THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres are riding a four-game point streak against the Wild, which is the longest point streak Buffalo has had against Minnesota.

Buffalo is 5-1-1 in its last seven games against Minnesota and six of the seven games have been decided by one goal.

The Sabres have scored on 42.9% of their power-play opportunities in their last six games against the Wild.

Casey Mittelstadt has registered at least one point in five consecutive games and he has recorded six points (2+4) in that span.

With a point tonight, **Mittelstadt** would match the longest point streak of his career. He previously recorded a six-game point streak (5+5) from April 6 to 14, 2023.

Alex Tuch has notched nine points (4+5) in his last seven games, including at least one goal in each of his last two contests.

Tage Thompson has notched 10 points (5+5) in his last seven games, including one point in each of his last two.

**Thompson** needs one assist to reach 100 in his career.

Rasmus Dahlin has recorded 11 points (3+8) in his last 12 games and a point in tonight's game would give him a three-game point streak.



A point in tonight's game would give him 25 point streaks of three or more games in his career and would move him into a tie with Rasmus Ristolainen for the sixth-most points by a defenseman in Sabres history (245).



### **SAVOIE MEETS WORLD**

If Matt Savoie makes his NHL debut tonight, he would be the 44th youngest (19 years, 313 days) skater and the 26th youngest forward to make their NHL debut with the Sabres.

Since 1995, only seven forwards (Zach Benson, Jack Eichel, Zemgus Girgensons, Mikhail Grigorenko, Casey Mittelstadt, Alexander Nylander, Sam Reinhart) younger than Savoie have made their NHL debut with Buffalo.




### WILD'N'OUT
