SAN DIEGO has earned standings points in eight of its last nine games (6-1-2) and 14 of the last 20 overall (11-6-3).

NIKITA NESTERENKO and **SASHA PASTUJOV** recorded the 10th and 11th hat tricks in Gulls history, Jan. 26 @ Iowa, the first time in franchise history two players have scored a hat trick in the same game. They are the third and fourth rookies in Gulls history to achieve the feat. Both players recorded 3-1=4 points, which are tied for the second-most points in a single game in Gulls history.

NESTERENKO'S mutil-goal game was his first at the AHL level. He was named the AHL Player of the Week for the period ending in Jan. 28 after earning 4-4=8 points in three games. He ranks tied for third among San Diego leaders in points (10-15=25), and is third in goals and assists.

PASTUJOV became the youngest Gull to record a hat trick at 20 years, six months and 12 days. He is the first San Diego player to record both his first AHL goal and hat trick in the same game. He now has 4-1=5 points the last two games, establishing his first professional goal streak.

PAVOL REGENDA leads the Gulls with 15 goals and ranks fifth in points (15-4=19) and is currently riding a career-long four-game goal streak (5-1=6).

CHASE DE LEO earned his 94th assist as a Gull, moving him into sole possession of second on the club's all-time assist list and is one assist shy of tying Sam Carrick (95) for the most in Gulls AHL history.

ANDREW AGOZZINO leads the Gulls in points (9-22=31) and ranks second in assists. He is currently riding a season-tying five-game point streak (1-4=5).

GLEN GAWDIN is second among Gulls leaders in goals (12) and fourth in points (12-12=24), earning points in seven of his last nine games (4-3=7).

TOMAS SUCHANEK has posted a 4-0-1 record in January, helping San Diego earn standings points in five consecutive starts. He has helped San Diego earn standings points in 10 of his 12 career starts (8-2-2), leading the Gulls in wins, GAA (2.40) and SV% (.921). Among AHL rookie goaltenders, he ranks tied for second in SV%, third in GAA and tied for eighth in wins.

YEGOR SIDOROV co-leads the WHL in GWG (9), ranks tied for second in goals (36), third in PPG (12) and tied for seventh in PPP (12-15=27). He leads Saskatoon in goals, PPG and GWG, while ranking second on the team in scoring and fourth in assists. Sidorov scored his 100th career WHL goal Jan. 31 (100-74=174 in 157 GP), while his 77 goals the last two seaons are tied for second among all WHL players. currently averaging 1.33 points per game and has 13-17=30 points his last 21 games.

CAREY TERRANCE ranks tied for second among OHL leaders in SHG (4) and tied for 15th in goals (24). He leads Erie in goals and SHG, while ranking third in points (24-15=39). Terrance has 1-2=3 points his last four games and is averaging 1.08 points per game.

RODWIN DIONICIO ranks tied for fifth among OHL defensemen in goals (13) and tied for sixth in points (13-28=41). He also ranks second among Saginaw blueliners in points, goals and assists. Dionicio has 2-9=11 points his last nine games and is one of six OHL defensemen to average more than a point per game pace this season (1.08).

CONNOR HVIDSTON has scored six goals his last nine games (6-3=9, +3) and his 1.15 points per game (20-17=37 in 32 GP) leads Swift Current while he ranks second among Broncos leaders in goals. He also paces Swift Current in PPG (9)

Over the weekend vs. No. 1 ranked Boston University, he scored goals in each game (2-0=2) to hekp Boston College move into the first in the nation.
