November 27, 2024 – CALGARY FLAMES [1] vs. DETROIT RED WINGS [2] (OT)

The Calgary Flames continued a four-game road trip on Wednesday night in Detroit. The home side would open the scoring 6:33 in the with Alex DeBrincat giving Detroit a 1-0 lead. The teams would trade chances through the rest of the first and second period, but Dan Vladar and Cam Talbot stood tall as the score remained 1-0 Red Wings heading into the third. In the final stanza, it would take until the 17:12 mark, but Connor Zary found a late equalizer for the Flames to force overtime. In the extra frame, Detroit would score to knock off the Flames 2-1.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the first of two meetings this season between the Flames and Blue Jackets. Calgary fell in both meetings with Columbus in the 2023-24 season.

This is a Pacific Division versus Metropolitan Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 5-1-0 against Metropolitan Division teams and a record of 6-2-3 against Eastern Conference opponents.

RIDE THE WAVE:

Forwards Yegor Sharangovich and Connor Zary both enter today's contest riding four-game point streaks. Sharangovich has three goals and two helpers during his run and is tied with MacKenzie Weegar for the team-lead in points with five since Nov. 21. Connor Zary has two goals and two assists, and his four points are the third-most on the club since Nov. 21.

POWER PLAY:

Following their powerplay goal on Wednesday night in Detroit, the Flames have struck on the man advantage in five-straight games. Since November 19th, the Flames are tied with the Carolina Hurricanes and Ottawa Senators with a league-leading six powerplay markers. Calgary also has the second-best powerplay efficiency in the league since November 19th at 42.9%, trailing only the Carolina Hurricanes (46.2%).

LOOK BACKS AT IT:

Mikael Backlund enters play tonight with 102 road goals in his NHL career, tied with Lanny McDonald for the fifth-most in Flames franchise history. With one more goal, Backlund can take soul-possession of fifth spot and the only players to score more road goals for the Flames are: Jarome Iginla (257), Theo Fleury (160), Joe Nieuwendyk (135), and Gary Roberts (110). Backlund leads all Swedish-born skaters in Flames franchise history in goals away from home, with Hakan Loob (96), and Kent Nilsson (87) sitting second and third respectively.

JUNIOR CONNECTIONS:

Flames blueliner Rasmus Andersson and Blue Jackets forward Kevin Labanc were teammates on the Barrie Colts of the OHL for the 2014-15 and 2015-16 campaign. Flames winger Blake Coleman and Blue Jackets centre Sean Kuraly played together on the USHL's Indiana Ice for two seasons from 2009 to 2011. The pair would also find themselves playing together again at Miami University (Ohio) for an additional three seasons from 2012-13 to 2014-15. A more recent connection includes Calgary's Matt Coronato and Columbus's Adam Fantilli who were USHL Champions with the Chicago Steel in 2020-21. Coronato was named the USHL's Forward of the Year after leading the league with 48 goals in 51 games.

AFTERNOON AFFAIRS:

The Flames get set to skate in their third matinee affair of the 2024-25 season, posting a 1-0-1 record in afternoon games thus far: Nov. 9 at BUF (2-3 SOL), Nov. 23 vs. MIN (4-3 SOW). Following today, the Flames next afternoon game will come on Dec. 21 when they welcome the Chicago Blackhawks to the Scotiabank Saddledome at 2:00pm MT.



BACK-TO-BACKS:

The Flames get set to begin their third back-to-back set of the 2024-25 season. In the Flames last set, they split the two contests on Nov. 11 vs. LAK (3-1 W) and VAN (1-3 L). Calgary has a 3-1-0 record in back-to-back games so far this season, and following their game in Pittsburgh tomorrow night, Calgary's next back-to-back will come on Dec. 28 and Dec. 29 when they face San Jose and Vegas on the road.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

Blue Jackets centre Sean Monahan spent the first nine seasons of his NHL career as a member of the Calgary Flames after being drafted sixth-overall by the Flames during the 2013 NHL Draft. Monahan's 656 games in a Flames sweater are the ninth-most in franchise history, and the Brampton, ON native recorded 212 goals and 250 assists for 462 points during his time in Calgary.
