# **PLAYERS TO WATCH**

## **MATHEW BARZAL #13**

Islanders forward Mathew Barzal has recorded 23 points (eight goals, 15 assists) in 20 career games against Columbus, leading active Islanders against the Blue Jackets. The 27-year-old has six points (two goals, four assists) in his last two games against Columbus, and has found the scoresheet 11 of the last 12 times he has faced them. The Coquitlam, BC native scored his second goal of the season last night against Anaheim, his first on the power play since February 18.



## SEAN MONAHAN #23

Blue Jackets forward Sean Monahan has recorded five points in his last four games (three goals, two assists) including his first multi-goal game of the season to help Columbus defeat Edmonton, 6-1, on Monday night. Monahan, 30, leads Columbus in goals (five), and enters tonight's game two assists shy of the 300th of his career, and one goal shy of his 250th. The Brampton, ON native has recorded 14 points (six goals, eight assists) in 17 career meetings against the Islanders.


