MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has earned points in three of the last four meetings (1-1-2), while Anaheim has won three of the last four season series.
- ★ The Ducks have won six consecutive games at Nationwide Arena (CBJ; 0-2-4) since CBJ's 4-2 win on Dec. 1, 2017.
- ★ The teams have played past regulation in two-straight in Ohio and six of the last nine at NWA since Feb. 11, 2016.
- ★ The winning team has scored four or more points in three-straight games of the series and six of the past seven, including four with five-plus goals.
- ★ The teams have combined for seven or more goals in five of the last seven contests in the series.
- ★ CBJ have scored a power play goal in four of the past five meetings of the series (5-of-17; 29.4 pct.).
- ★ The Jackets have killed off all Ducks power play chances over the last 17 meetings since Feb. 11, 2016 (42 attempts).



JACKET TO WATCH - C Sean Monahan

Has 9-14-23 with five multi point games in 35 career GP vs. the Ducks. Has registered points in four of his last six home contests vs. the club (3-5-8).



DUCK TO WATCH - RW Troy Terry

Has 4-9-13 with 5 multi-point efforts in 9 career GP against Columbus. Has points in 6 of the last 7 matchups (4-9-13), including a current three-game assists streak (1-5-6).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets continue a four-game homestand on Tuesday. The club is in a stretch of 15-of-23 games played at home from Dec. 11-Jan. 28.
- ★ The team has played in 13 one-goal games (5-2-6) in its past 19 overall, including 10 decided after regulation.
- ★ CBJ rank second in the NHL in goals scored by defensemen and rank eighth-T in total points with 23-51-74.
- ★ Columbus has scored a power play goal in five of the past seven contests (6-for-21; 28.6 pct.). The team has converted on 10-of-43 opportunities over the last 17 contests since Nov. 11 (23.3 pct.; 10th in NHL).
- ★ The Jackets are tied for 12th in the NHL in goals scored during 5v5 play (66).
- ★ The team is in a stretch of five-straight games against the Western Conference from Dec. 13-22.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C **Adam Fantilli** has posted 9-6-15 in 19 games since Nov. 8 (.79 points-per-game).
- ★ C **Boone Jenner** sits five points shy of becoming the third player in franchise history to record 400 career points (203-192-395, 759 GP).
- ★ G **Jet Greaves** has stopped 314-of-344 in his past 12 games played since Nov. 11 (.913 SV%, 2.49 GAA).
- ★ LW **Dmitri Voronkov** has notched goals in three of the last five games (3-1-4) and leads the club in goals (12) and power play goals (5) this season.
- ★ D **Zach Werenski** collected an assist on Saturday and has points in 13 of the last 16 games overall (5-17-22). He ranks second in the NHL in TOI/GP as well as leads league blueliners in multi-point efforts and shots on goal and ranks second in points and third in goals (tied) and assists with 9-24-33, 11 multi-point GP, 116 shots and 26:37 TOI in 32 contests.
- ★ **Werenski** has points in 10-straight games at Nationwide Arena since Oct. 29 (5-12-17), tied for the second-longest home points streak in franchise history (Bjorkstrand, Feb. 27-Mar. 29, 2022).
