Eller's two-goal game on Sunday extended his point streak to four games, tying his career-long streak that he has accomplished eight previous times in his career, most recently from April 10-16, 2022.

OFFENSE FROM THE DEFENSE

Penguins defensemen Kris Letang and Erik Karlsson have put up points against the Flames throughout their careers.

- Letang has four goals, 15 assists and 19 points in 22 career games against Calgary, which is his second most against any Western Conference team.
- Karlsson has four goals, 18 assists and 22 points in 28 career games against the Flames.
