## PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars have the day off on Thursday, Nov. 23. They'll hold morning skate on Friday, Nov. 24 at 10:30 a.m. CT at American Airlines Center prior to their game against the Calgary Flames (7:30 p.m. CT).

## NOTES:

- The Stars enter the Thanksgiving holiday in first place in the Central Division with 26 points (12-4-2), having earned five wins in their past seven games (5-1-1).
- With an assist, forward **Jason Robertson** (109-141—250 in 228 GP) recorded his 250th career point and joined **Jimmy Carson** (209 GP), **Neal Broten** (219 GP), **Joe Mullen** (222 GP) and **Craig Janney** (225 GP) as the fifth U.S.-born player in NHL history to record 250 career points in 228 contests or fewer.
- Robertson's assist gave him points in four of his past five games (2-4—6) and 16 points (5-11—16) in 17 GP this season.
- Forward **Roope Hintz** (1-0—1) tallied his eighth goal of the season at the 19:17 mark of the second period. Hintz has goals in each of his past two games (2-2—4) and in three of his previous four overall (3-2—5).
- Forward **Joe Pavelski** picked up his 10th assist and team-leading 18th point (8-10—18) of the season.
- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** made 24 saves on 26 shots.
