AT A GLANCE

CAN'T STOP BRANDT

Rookie defenseman **Brandt Clarke** skates into Crypto.com Arena fresh off scoring his fifth goal of the season Sunday night in Vegas as part of his fourth multipoint game (1-1=2) of the season and fifth of his career. With his goal, Clarke is the first Kings blueliner 22 years of age or younger to tally five or more goals in a single season since **Drew Doughty** (10 G) in 2011-12. With 27 points (5-22=27) in 58 games this season, Clarke is one of 12 defensemen in franchise history with as many points in a single season before turning 23 years of age, and just the second to do so in the last 30 years behind Doughty (4x, Last: 10-26=36 in 2011-12).

JUICE IS LOOSE

Forward **Adrian Kempe** (1-1=2) scored his fifth power play goal of the season on Sunday night in Las Vegas, standing as his fourth game-winning goal of the year and securing his team-leading 18th multi-point night of the year. In his last effort at Crypto.com Arena on Saturday night, Kempe (0-1=1) registered his 25th helper of the campaign by feeding **Quinton Byfield** for the decisive marker early into the extra frame against the Blues. With a pair of points (1-1=2) in his last head-to-head with the Islanders on Dec. 10, 2024, Kempe enters tomorrow on a three-game goal streak against the club. He has totaled five points (3-2=5) in his last four games played against New York, including the game-winner the last time that they came to Crypto.com Arena, exactly one year ago on March 11, 2024.

BRAVO GOING DARC

Goaltender Darcy Kuemper turned aside 19 of St. Louis' 20 shots on goal in his last time between the pipes on Saturday evening, improving his record to 19-8-7 on the year. As part of his 197th career NHL win, the native of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, helped the Kings secure points in his 10th consecutive home-ice appearance (9-0-1), tied for the third longest such streak within a single season in franchise history. He trails only **Rogie Vachon** (11 GP, 8-0-3 in 1972-73) and **Kelly Hrudey** (12 GP, 11-0-1 in 1990-91).
