

Gustafsson played the majority of the 2022-23 season with the Washington Capitals, producing 38 points (7G, 31A) in 61 games, pacing all Washington defensemen in points and assists and finishing tied for second in goals. He totaled 42 points (7G, 35A) in 70 combined contests with Toronto and Washington during the 2022-23 campaign. Originally selected by Edmonton in the fourth round (93rd overall) in the 2012 NHL Draft, Gustafsson has recorded 191 points (39G, 152A) in 379 career NHL games with Chicago, Calgary, Philadelphia, Montreal, Toronto and Washington. The Nynashamn, Sweden, native played two seasons for Frolunda in the Swedish Hockey League from 2013-15 and represented his country at the IIHFWorld Championship in 2016, 2018, 2019 and 2022.
