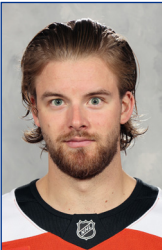

TOP NOTES

Rasmus Dahlin's first goal marked the third time this season he had scored the first goal of a game, tied for the second-most among all NHL defensemen in 2025-26. **Dahlin's** second goal of the game marked the fifth multi-goal game of his career, tied with Jerry Korab and John Van Boxmeer for the second-most multi-goal games by a Sabres defenseman in franchise history.

Dahlin became the first Sabres defenseman since Rasmus Ristolainen on Dec. 10, 2015 at Calgary to record multiple power-play goals in a single game.

With his two assists, **Josh Doan** has now registered eight points (4+4) in his last seven games. His game marked his third multi-assist effort of the season and his first since Dec. 1 vs. Winnipeg (0+2). It was the fifth game of his career in which he had tallied two or more assists.

Tage Thompson recorded an assist on both of **Dahlin's** goals. He has tallied 23 points (10+13) in his last 20 games, including 13 points (4+9) in his last 10 games and at least one point in five consecutive contests (2+5). The assists gave him his third point streak of five or more games this season.

Thompson's assist on **Dahlin's** second goal marked his fourth multi-assist game of 2025-26 and the 25th of his career. He last recorded multiple assists on Dec. 27 vs. Boston (0+2).

As a result of his goal, **Mattias Samuelsson** has now scored more goals in 2025-26 (8) than he had in his career entering this season (7).

Jack Quinn scored the Sabres' third goal. **Quinn** has posted 11 points (7+4) in his last eight games against the Flyers, including at least one point in five consecutive games against Philadelphia. His 1.10 points per game in 10 career games against Philadelphia is the highest per-game average against the Flyers among all current Sabres skaters.

With his two points, **Ryan McLeod** has recorded seven points (3+4) in his last five games, including at least one point in each of the games in that span. As a result, he matched the longest point streak of his career (five games) and established the longest assist streak of his career (four games).

In his last six games against the Flyers including tonight, **McLeod** has tallied 10 points (4+6), including six points (3+3) in three home games against Philadelphia as a member of the Sabres.

Josh Norris picked up the primary assist on **Dahlin's** second goal and he has recorded seven points (4+3) in his last seven games against the Flyers, including at least one point in four straight games against Philadelphia (2+3).
