MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus won the season series against Pittsburgh for the sixth time in franchise history in 2024-25 and for the first time since the 2016-17 campaign.
- ★ Columbus has won three of the last four contests in the series and has points in five of the last nine meetings (4-4-1).
- * Two of the last four games in the series have been decided by a shootout, both won by CBJ.
- ★ The winning team has scored four-plus goals in 11 of the past 13 games of the overall series (including SO goals).
- ★ The teams have combined for six goals or more in seven of the last nine outings.
- ★ LW Kent Johnson has tallied 2-3-5 in seven career outings against Pittsburgh and has points in each of his past three outings at PPG Paints Arena (1-3-4).
- RW Kirill Marchenko has 2-3-5 in nine career games vs. the Penguins with 1-3-4 in the past four appearances.



JACKET TO WATCH - C CHARLIE COYLE

Has posted 6-14-20 with 4 multi-point efforts in 34 career GP against Pittsburgh and has points in 5-straight GP (2-4-6). Has tallied 3-7-10 in 17 career games at PPG Paints Arena.





PENGUIN TO WATCH - C SIDNEY CROSBY

Has 21-44-65 with 20 multi-point efforts in 45 GP against the Blue Jackets. Has notched points in each of the last five contests (1-7-8) and 10 of the last 11 contests (8-14-22).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus, which is in the middle of a stretch of three-of-four games played away from Nationwide Arena from Oct. 21-28, has won two-straight road contests (7-4 W at MIN on Oct. 11 and 5-1 W at DAL on Oct. 21).
- ★ The Blue Jackets complete their first of 15 back-to-back sets of the season tonight at Pittsburgh. CBJ play three-straight back-to-back sets from Oct. 24-Nov. 2 (also Oct. 28 at BUF/Oct. 29 vs. TOR and Nov. 1 vs. STL/Nov. 2 at NYI).
- ★ CBJ have scored first in four of the past six contests. The club scored the first goal 43 times in 2024-25 (10th-T in NHL).
- ★ Columbus has outscored opponents 14-9 during 5-on-5 play in 2025-26 with the nine goals allowed the second-fewest in the NHL (WSH, 8).

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ LW Zach Aston-Reese (48-51-99, 396 GP) sits one point shy of 100 for his NHL career and C Charlie Coyle (189-299-488, 957 GP) is one assist from 300.
- * RW Kirill Marchenko had his five-game points streak (5-2-7) snapped in Friday's loss to the Capitals. He leads the club in goals and points (tied) this season.
- ★ D Denton Mateychuk has recorded goals in consecutive games for the first time in his career after scoring at Dallas and the club's lone goal on Friday.
- ★ G Elvis Merzlikins has turned aside 102-of-110 shots faced in his first three games of 2025-26 (2-1-0, 2.69 GAA, .927 SV%).
- * C Sean Monahan collected an assist for the second-straight game on Friday and sits three points from 600 for his NHL career (263-334-597, 825 GP). He would become the fourth player from the 2013 NHL Draft class to reach the mark, joining C Nathan MacKinnon (1,026 points), C Aleksander Barkov (782 points) and C Elias Lindholm (611 points).
- * LW Dmitri Voronkov stretched his points streak to three-straight (1-2-3) with an assist against the Capitals and has tallied points in six of the Blue Jackets' seven games this season (3-4-7).
