THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

JJ Peterka has tallied 34 points (16+18) in his last 31 games and he has registered 11 points (4+7) in his last nine games.

Peterka has recorded at least one point in five straight games (3+3) and he would match the second-longest point streak of his career (twice) with a point in tonight's game.

Tagge Thompson has posted 47 points (28+19) in his last 45 games, including 12 points (10+2) in his last 11 games.

Alex Tuch has registered 14 points (8+6) in his last 10 games.

Tuch has recorded one point in back-to-back games (1+1) and a point tonight would mark his eighth point streak of three or more games this season.

Jack Quinn has tallied 11 points (4+7) in his last 11 games.

Lindy Ruff is one win away from becoming just the fifth coach in NHL history to reach 900 regular-season wins in their career.

SWEDE DREAMS (ARE MADE OF THIS)

Rasmus Dahlin has posted 16 points (5+11) in his last 12 games, including nine points (3+6) in his last six contests.

Dahlin has recorded two points in three straight games and a multi-point performance tonight would make him the fourth Sabres defenseman all-time (Phil Housley, twice; Andrej Sekera; John Van Boxmeer) to register a multi-point streak of four or more games.

Dating back to Dec. 23, **Dahlin** leads all NHL defensemen in assists (38), points (49), and points per game (1.09).

Dahlin ranks fourth among all NHL defensemen in points (68), is tied for fourth in goals (17) and ranks tied for sixth in assists (51).

Dahlin ranked fourth among all NHL defensemen in points per game (0.96).

Dahlin leads all Sabres skaters with 10 multi-assist games and 19 multi-point games this season.

Alex Tuch has registered 14 points (7+7) in his last 10 games against Toronto, including six points (1+5) in his last four home games against Toronto.

Dating back to the beginning of the 2021-22 season, **Tagge Thompson** has 13 points (6+7) in 13 games against Toronto.

Thompson has posted eight points (3+5) in his last six home games against the Maple Leafs.

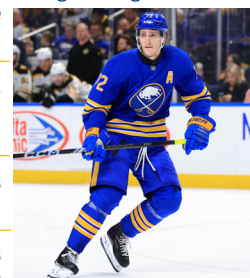
JJ Peterka has tallied nine points (2+7) in his last seven games against Toronto, including two straight multi-point performances against the Maple Leafs.
