AT A GLANCE

JUICY JANUARY

Forward **Adrian Kempe** scored his 200th career goal in the first period of the Kings' 3-0 shutout of the Winnipeg Jets at Crypto.com Arena on Nov. 4, 2025. The goal, which ultimately stood as the game-winning tally, made the native of Kramfors, Sweden, the 10th player in franchise history to score 200 goals in a Kings uniform. The 29-year-old forward skates into the season-series-finale with the Jets on an active six-game point streak against the Manitoba-based franchise (5-5=10 in 6 GP), dating back to April 1, 2024, which is the longest active point streak against Winnipeg among any League skater.

CAN'T CATCH 22

On Wednesday night, forward **Kevin Fiala** notched his 15th assist of the campaign before scoring his 16th goal of the season to break a tie with **Adrian Kempe** (15 G) for sole possession of the most goals by a Kings skater this season. Fiala's 132nd career multi-point game extended Fiala's point streak to a fifth consecutive game (2-4=6), dating back to Dec. 29, 2025, in Colorado. The current run is Fiala's second separate point streak of at least five games in length so far this season, following a five-game streak (3-2=5) recorded from Oct. 13 – 23, 2025.

DULUTH TRAINING COMPANY

Tomorrow's contest against the Winnipeg Jets will feature a quartet of University of Minnesota-Duluth alumni, including Kings defenseman **Mikey Anderson** (2017-19) and Winnipeg's **Neal Pionk** (2015-17) and **Alex Lafallo** (2013-2017), and **Dylan Samberg** (2017-20). During their collegiate years, Anderson's defensive partner was Samberg. Three of the four skaters sit in the top five on the all-time games played list among active Minnesota-Duluth hockey alumnus in the NHL. In the Kings' last visit to Manitoba on Saturday, Oct. 11, 2025, Anderson opened the scoring for his side with his first goal of the season and his first career tally against Winnipeg. He now has a pair of points across two straight games against the Jets by following that road performance with his first assist of the campaign in the Jets' visit to DTLA on Tuesday, Nov. 4, 2025.
