AT A GLANCE

EXTRA JUICE

Adrian Kempe skates into Alberta with the most points of any skater in the playoffs. Through the first two games of Round One, the winger posted a teamleading three goals and seven points (3-4=7), including his first career four-point (2-2=4) playoff game in Game 2 on Wednesday night. With his pair of multi-point performances (1-2=3 in Game 1; 2-24 in Game 2), Kempe is the first player in team history with back-to-back three-point games to start a postseason and the first with seven points through the team's first two playoff games – one point more than the next closest (Wayne Gretzky: 1-5=6 in 2 GP; 1990), per NHL PR.

KING OF KINGS

Anze Kopitar is set to skate in his 100th career Stanley Cup Playoff game on Friday night fresh off recording his second career four-point (1-3=4) playoff game as he joins Wayne Gretzky (6 GP), Bernie Nicholls (2 GP), Drew Doughty (2 GP) and Dave Taylor (2 GP) as the only skaters in franchise history with multiple fourpoint playoff outings. It also marked the captain's ninth career multi-assist postseason game, the third most such postseason efforts behind Gretzky (17 GP) and Luc Robitaille (11 GP). With five points (1-4=5) through the first two games of this First Round series, Kopitar has accumulated 26 goals and 85 points (26-59=85) in 99 career playoff games spread over 10 postseasons and 18 different series. Only Gretzky (29-65=94) and Robitaille (41-48=89) have more in LA Kings history.

WAR-REN PEACE

Warren Foegele returns to Rogers Place for his first postseason appearance in the building since his two-point game (1-1=2) on June 21, 2024, to force Game 7 in the Stanley Cup Final. The winger (0-2=2) tallied his first postseason points as an LA King in Wednesday's Game 2 matchup against his former team. Foegele reached 26 career playoff points (12-14=26) to pass **Kevin Fiala** (12-13=25) for 13th most playoff points among skaters selected in the 2014 NHL Draft.
