

The New York Rangers selected goaltender Talyn Boyko with the 112th overall pick in the 2021 NHL Draft. Boyko appeared in 14 games with the Tri-City Americans of the Western Hockey League (WHL) last season, posting a 7-7-0 record, along with a 3.02 GAA, a .901 SV%, and 1 SO. The 6-7, 196-pounder established WHL career-bests in several categories in 2020-21, including wins, GAA, and SV%. The Drumheller, Alberta native has appeared in 48 career WHL games over parts of three seasons (2018-19 – 2020-21), all with Tri-City. Took part in the Rangers 2021 Development Camp.
