
HOME SWEET HOME

The Kings are set to take the ice at Crypto.com Arena for the first time this season as they play host to the San Jose Sharks. The team ended 2023-24 campaign having won nine of their last 10 home games, including eight consecutive victories at Crypto.com Arena from March 11 through April 13 to mark the team's longest home winning streak since the 2010-11 campaign (8-0-0 from Oct. 12 - Nov. 13, 2010). Following the team's All-Star Break and Bye Week (Feb. 10), the Kings became one of the best teams at home with a league-leading 14 wins (14-3-1) and .806 points percentage (PTS%). The team ended the season sitting in the top-five of multiple home categories and led the league in PTS% and wins.

KOPI GOING FISHIN'

Captain Anze Kopitar has consistently found the scoring sheet throughout his career against the Pacific Division rival Sharks with 70 points (27-43=70) in 93 career games vs. San Jose. Kopitar leads all active skaters in points and places fourth all-time, three points shy of tying Mike Modano (24-49=73) for third-most. Kopitar is one of two active skaters (Corey Perry, 28G) to eclipse the 20-goal mark against San Jose while he (43A, 28 PPP) and Drew Doughty (31A, 20 PPP) pace all active skaters in assists and power-play points (PPP) against San Jose.


