TOP NOTES

Tonight's win gave the Sabres 93 shootout wins in franchise history, the most among all NHL teams all-time.

With his 40th goal of the season, **Tage Thompson** became the first Sabres skater since Thomas Vanek (2006-07, 43 goals; 2008-09, 40 goals) to record multiple seasons of 40 or more goals with Buffalo.

Thompson is now the eighth Sabres skater to register at least 40 goals in two or more seasons with Buffalo all-time (Dave Andreychuk, two times; Danny Gare, three times; Pat LaFontaine, three times; Rick Martin, five times; Gilbert Perreault, three times; Rene Robert, two times; Thomas Vanek, two times).

Thompson's goal marked his fifth goal streak of three or more games this season, tied tor the most he has recorded in a single season in his career (2022-23).

As a result of his assist on **Thompson's** goal, **Zach Benson** has tallied at least one point in three straight games against Tampa Bay (1+3).

Jason Zucker's goal gave him a three-game point streak and he has collected four points (1+3) in that span. It marked the second time he has scored to a tie a game in the third period this season (March 15 vs. Vegas). The goal was **Zucker's** 20th of the season, which marked the seventh time he has scored 20 or more goals in a single season.

Alex Tuch recorded the primary assist on **Zucker's** goal. In his last seven games including tonight, **Tuch** has posted 10 points (6+4), including at least one point in five straight games.

Tuch's shootout goal moved him to 8-for-14 (57.1 percent) on shootout attempts as a member of the Sabres, the highest percentage for any Sabres skater with at least 10 shootout attempts with Buffalo all-time.

Rasmus Dahlin also recorded an assist on **Zucker's** goal and he has posted 11 points (2+9) in his last nine games against Tampa Bay.
