SHARKBAIT OOH HA HA!

The Kings skate into SAP Center riding a nine-game point streak against the Sharks (8-0-1), dating back to March 17, 2022. It is one of three active point streaks of at least nine games against any one opponent for the Kings. Should the team collect a point tonight, it would mark the 15th different point streak of at least 10 games against any one opponent in franchise history.


CAPTAIN KOPI AT THE WHEEL

Forward Anze Kopitar has consistently found the scoring sheet throughout his career against the Pacific Division rival Sharks with 70 points (27-43=70) in 94 career games vs. San Jose. Kopitar leads all active skaters in points and places fourth all-time, three points shy of tying **Mike Modano** (24-49=73) for third-most against the Bay Area franchise. Kopitar is one of two active skaters (Corey Perry, 28G) to eclipse the 20-goal mark against San Jose while he (43A, 28 PPP) and Drew Doughty (31A, 20 PPP) pace all active skaters in assists and power-play points (PPP). Through the first nine games of the campaign, the Kings' captain leads the Kings in scoring with nine points (3-6=9) and recently surpassed **Jari Kurri** for sole possession of the 35th-most assists in NHL history with his 798th career helper coming Saturday afternoon against Utah.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'

In the last contest between the Kings and Sharks on Oct. 24, Thousand Oaks, Calif. native Trevor Moore recorded his 100th career assist. The 29-year-old winger scored a career-high 31 goals and 57 points (31-26=57) in 82 games played to lead the Kings in goalscoring last season. Of those 31 tallies, 27 came at even-strength, ranking among the top 15 in the NHL. A veteran of 354 regular season contests, Moore became the seventh different California-born skater in league history to reach 100 assists with his helper against the Sharks. Moore enters tonight with 164 points (72-92=164) in 302 games played for the LA Kings organization, the most points tallied by a California-born player for a California-based team all-time.


