PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars will hold practice at 11:30 a.m. CT at American Airlines Center on Wednesday, April 10. Prior to practice, the Stars will take a team photo at American Airlines Center at 11 a.m. CT.

NOTES

- The Stars (50-20-9, 109 points) recorded the franchise's fifth 50-win season and first since 2015-16 (50) with a 3-2 victory over Buffalo.

- Forward **Jason Robertson** (1-0—1) picked up his 28th goal of the season at the 6:15 mark of the opening frame. Through 79 GP, Robertson leads the club in points (28-50—78).

- Forward **Roope Hintz** (0-1—1) recorded his 35th assist of the season to give him points in three straight (2-1—3) and in five of his past six (4-4—8).

- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** (1-0—1) tallied his team-leading 32nd goal at the 3:38 mark of the middle frame. The 20-year-old now has goals in nine of his past 14 games (10-7—17) and continues to pace the club in goals.

- Fresh off a three-assist performance on Sunday at Colorado, defenseman **Thomas Harley** recorded two more assists (0-2—2) against Buffalo on Tuesday. Harley, 22, leads Stars blueliners in goals (15) and ranks second in assists (31) and points (15-31—46) in 76 GP.

- Forward **Joe Pavelski** (1-0—1) pushed his point streak to three consecutive games (1-2—3) with his 27th goal of the season. Pavelski has points in six of his past seven games (2-5—7).

- With an assist, (0-1—1), defenseman **Chris Tanev** increased his point streak to three consecutive games, one shy of his career high (4) done twice (Feb. 2-12, 2022 w/ CGY and Jan. 27-Feb. 2, 2020 w/ VAN).
