PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars enter their bye week/All-Star break and will resume practice Sunday, Feb. 4 at 2 p.m. CT at Comerica Center.

NOTES

- Dallas (30-13-6, 66 points) reached the 30-win mark in a season in fewer than 50 games for the fifth time in franchise history, following 2005-06 (44 GP), 1998-99 (46 GP), 2015-16 (48 GP) and 1997-98 (49 GP).

- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** (2-0—2) scored his third overtime goal of 2023-24 (and his second OT winner is consecutive games) and tied **Tyler Seguin** (3 in 2019-20) and **John Klingberg** (3 in 2015-16) for the most by a player history in a single season in franchise history. Harley ranks among the league's top-five in goals by defensemen and is second among Stars blueliners in points (12-17—29).

- Following a special pregame ceremony honoring 1,000 games played, forward **Matt Duchene** put together a multi-point performance (1-1—2), including an assist on Harley's game-winning goal in OT. Duchene has goals in two straight (2-1—3) and points in three consecutive games (2-2—4). The 33-year-old has 45 points (17-28—45) in 48 games this season.

- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** (38-35—73 in 131 GP) moved within one of **Tom McCarthy** (39) for the third-most goals by a player before age 21 in franchise history. **Brian Bellows** (102) and **Mike Modano** (57) sit first and second on the list, respectively. Johnston's goal was his 14th of the season and gave him 32 points (14-18—32) in 49 GP.

- Forward **Mason Marchment** scored his 16th goal of the 2023-24 campaign as part of a two-point performance (1-1—2). Marchment has points in three straight (2-2—4) and 37 points (16-21—37) overall. Marchment is three goals away from setting a new career high for goals in a season (18).

- Defenseman **Miro Heiskanen's** point streak reached three consecutive games with a multi-assist performance (0-2—2) against the Capitals. Heiskanen has a goal and three points (1-2—3) in two games since returning from a lower-body injury that held him out for 10 contests. Heiskanen paces Stars blueliners with 30 points (5-25—30).

- Forward **Tyler Seguin** pushed his point streak to three consecutive games (0-4—4) with a multi-assist performance (0-2—2) vs. Washington.

- Forward **Jason Robertson** (0-1—1) recorded his team-leading 33rd assist of the season with the primary helper on Harley's game winner. Robertson has points in 17 of his past 20 overall (8-15—23).

- Forward **Roope Hintz** picked up his 25th assist of the season to give him 47 points (22-25—47) in 47 GP.

- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** made 22 saves on 26 shots to boost his record this season to 16-9-2.
