- With his first of two points tonight, forward **Roope Hintz** recorded his 250th point (119-131—250) in his 318th career NHL game to become the fastest player in <u>Dallas Stars history</u> (1993-present) to reach the 250-point mark.

- Hintz (1-1—2) recorded his first multi-point game of the season and has points (3-3—6) in five of his six games of the 2023-24 campaign.
- Skating in his 1,257th career game, forward **Joe Pavelski** surpassed Brian Rolston (1,256 GP) and Craig Ludwig (1,256 GP) for sole possession of the 11th-most games by a U.S.-born player in NHL history.
- Forward **Jason Robertson** picked up his second multi-point game of the season with two assists (0-2—2). Robertson has points (1-5—6) in four of his seven games this season.
- Forward **Matt Duchene** (1-0—1) picked up his first goal as a member of the Stars at the 2:49 mark of the third period, giving him points in three consecutive games (1-2—3).
- Forward **Evgenii Dadonov** registered his second goal of the season and first multi-point performance with two points (1-1—2).
- Captain **Jamie Benn** had two assists (0-2—2) to give him points in three of his past four games (1-4—5).
- Defenseman Nils Lundkvist recorded his first point of the season with an assist against the Jackets.
- Defenseman Ryan Suter extended his point streak to two consecutive games (0-2-2) with an assist.
- With a 22-save performance, goaltender Jake Oettinger improved to 8-0-1 in his career against Columbus.
