- The Stars fell short to the Ducks 4-2 in Dallas, giving the Stars their first “home” loss at American Airlines Center. Monday’s matchup was the Ducks first win in Dallas since March 1, 2015.
- Six different skaters recorded a point during the game. Both **Esa Lindell** and **Matt Duchene** tallied a goal for the Stars.
- **Mason Marchment** earned a point with an assist during the game, recording his 100th NHL assist and extending his point streak to four games (Nov. 11 – Nov. 18). During this span, **Marchment** has totaled 10 points in four games played (4-6–10).

### GAME NOTES

#### THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the second of three games the Stars will play against the Sharks this season and the final time that the teams will play in Dallas this year. They will next face off on Feb. 8, 2025 in San Jose.
- Tonight is the second consecutive game in which the Stars will face off against a Pacific Division team. They have a 3-1-0 record against Pacific Division opponents this year.
- A Stars victory would extend Dallas’ winning streak against the Sharks to five games, after the team defeated San Jose 3-2 in a shootout earlier this year and went a perfect 3-0-0 against the Sharks last season.
- The Stars enter tonight’s game two wins shy of recording their 2,000th win in franchise history.
- The Stars have allowed only 2.35 goals against per game this season, which was tied with Minnesota for the best mark in the NHL entering play Tuesday.
- Dallas has outscored its opponents 56-40 this season. Their plus-16 goal differential was tied for the sixth-best mark in the NHL this year entering play Sunday.
- **Tyler Seguin** is one assist away from bringing his total with the Stars to 381, which would give him sole possession of fifth on the franchise’s all-time assists list.

### IDES OF MARCH

- **Mason Marchment** was named the NHL’s Second Star of the Week for the week ending in Nov. 17 after totaling nine points (4-5–9) in three games, the most of any player during that span.
  - It marked the second time in his career that he has earned Star of the Week honors after being named the Third Star of the Week on Feb. 6, 2022 after totaling six points (2-4–6) in two games while playing for the Florida Panthers.
  - It is also the second time this season that a Stars player has earned Star of the Week honors after **Matt Duchene** was named the league’s Third Star of the Week for the week ending in Oct. 27.
- **Marchment** recorded in assist in Dallas’ last game on Nov. 18 against the Anaheim Ducks to bring his season total to 18 points (6-12–18), which ranks second on the team in scoring.

- The helper marked the 100th assist of his NHL career, which made him the 18th undrafted, active skater to reach the 100-assist milestone.
- **Marchment** has totaled 10 points (4-6-10) over the Stars' last four games dating back to Nov. 11. His 10 points during that span were the most in the NHL entering play Tuesday.
- A goal or an assist tonight would give **Marchment** points in five consecutive games for the first time since he recorded a nine-game point streak from Jan. 23 to Feb. 17, 2024.
- The 2024-25 season marks the first time in his career that **Marchment** has played at a point-per-game pace or better through his first 16 games played of a season.
- His 18 points are already 34.0 percent of his career high of 53 (22-31-53) that he reached last season in 81 games. **Marchment** is currently pacing to finish the year with 30 goals, 61 assists and 91 points, all of which would be career highs.
- **Marchment** has a plus-12 on-ice, even-strength goal differential this season, which was tied for fourth all NHL forwards entering play Tuesday.
- **Marchment** recorded five points (1-4-5) in Dallas' 7-1 win over the Pittsburgh Penguins on Nov. 11, making him one of four skaters this season to record a five-point game
  - It was the second-highest scoring game of his career, trailing only the six points (2-4-6) he had against the Columbus Blue Jackets on Jan. 31, 2022.
  - **Marchment** joined Artemi Panarin (5) as the only active undrafted players with multiple five-point games according to NHL Stats.
- **Marchment** (1-4-5) became the third Stars player in the last decade to record five points in a game, following **Wyatt Johnston** (March 5, 2024) and Joe Pavelski (Jan. 12, 2022) according to NHL Stats.

### SHARK BAIT

- **Jamie Benn** has played at a point-per-game pace against the Sharks since March 5, 2011, totaling 42 points (17-25-42) in 42 games.
  - In all **Benn** has 48 career points (19-29-48) against San Jose, which is tied with Nathan MacKinnon for the third-highest total of any active skater.
- **Wyatt Johnston** has nine points (5-4-9) in six career games against San Jose, which includes scoring his first career hat trick and notching a career-high five points (3-2-5) on March 5, 2024 against the Sharks.
  - He enters tonight's game riding a three-game point streak against San Jose.
- **Miro Heiskanen** has 15 points (2-13-15) in 14 career games against the Sharks.
  - **Heiskanen's** 1.07 points per game against San Jose ranks fifth among active defensemen that have played the Sharks at least three times in their career.
- **Jason Robertson** has 12 points (6-6-12) in 10 career games against the Sharks and enters tonight's matchup riding a seven-game point streak against San Jose, totaling 10 points (5-5-10) in those games.
- **Tyler Seguin** has 21 points (8-13-21) in the last 21 games he has played against San Jose dating back to Feb. 5, 2014.
- **Logan Stankoven** has five points (2-3-5) in four career games against the Sharks.

### LIND, LAUGH, LOVE

- **Esa Lindell** scored in Dallas' last game on Nov. 18 against the Ducks and now has four points (1-3-4) in his last four games played.
- With eight points (2-6-8) in 17 games played this season, **Lindell** enters tonight's contest against the Sharks tied with **Thomas Harley** (1-7-8) for the team lead in scoring among defensemen.
- **Lindell** enters tonight's game one point shy of totaling 200 career points. When he reaches the milestone, he will become the 13th defenseman from the 2012 NHL Draft class to total 200 points.
- He will also become the 49th player and 13th defenseman in franchise history to record 200 points with the Stars.
- **Lindell** is one goal away from tying Philippe Boucher (52) for 10th in franchise history in goals scored by a defenseman.
- **Lindell** is currently on pace to finish the year with 29 assists and 39 points, both of which would be career highs for the 10-year veteran.
- He is averaging 3:21 of shorthanded ice time per game this season, which was the 10th-highest mark in the NHL entering play Tuesday.

### SLIDING INTO YOUR DMS

- **Matt Duchene**, **Mason Marchment** and **Tyler Seguin** have combined for 23 goals this season, accounting for 41.1 percent of Dallas' total offense this season.
- According to Natural Stat Trick, when the trio is on the ice during 5-on-5 play, the Stars are outscoring their opponents 8-4, outshooting them 77-58 and have 72 scoring chances to their opponents' 55.
- Additionally, according to MoneyPuck.com, the **Duchene/Marchment/Seguin** line has 59.8 expected goals for percentage this year, which ranks 11th among all NHL forward lines to play at least 100 minutes together this season.
- All three of **Duchene** (1.24), **Marchment** (1.13) and **Seguin** (1.15) are playing at a point-per-game pace this season. Only Tampa Bay Lightning (six) and Washington Capitals (four) had more players playing at a point-per-game rate or better this season entering play Tuesday.
- The trio also ranks first (**Duchene**), second (**Marchment**) and third (**Seguin**) in scoring on the Stars roster this season.

## FACING OFF

- **Jamie Benn** went 10-for-11 at the faceoff dot in Dallas' last game on Nov. 18 for a 90.9 percent success rate. **Benn** is one of four players this season to take at least 10 draws while only losing one or fewer and the only player to do it twice (16-for-16 on Nov. 7 vs. CHI).
- **Benn** previously went a perfect 16-for-16 at the faceoff dot on Nov. 7 against the Chicago Blackhawks. It marked the first time in his career that he has taken at least 16 draws in a game without losing one.
- Since the NHL began tracking faceoffs in 1997-98, **Benn** became just the sixth player to go undefeated at the faceoff dot when taking at least 16 draws.
- **Benn** has gone 92-for-141 at the faceoff dot this season. His 65.3 percent success rate was the second-best mark in the NHL this year among skaters to take at least 20 draws entering play Tuesday.
- The Stars won 45 of the 68 faceoffs (66.2 percent) in their last game on Nov. 18 against the Ducks, marking the third time this season that they have had a faceoff win percentage of 60 percent or higher in a game.
- In all, the Stars have won 51.5 percent of the faceoffs they have taken this season, which was the 11th-best mark in the NHL entering play Tuesday.

## FIRST THING'S FIRST

- The Stars have opened the scoring in 62.5 percent of the games that they have played this season, recording the first goal of the game in 10 of their 17 games.
- Dallas has gone on to win nine of the 10 games that they have scored first in. Their nine wins when scoring first were tied with Minnesota for the second-best mark in the league this season entering play Tuesday.
- Additionally, the Stars' .900 win percentage when scoring first this year was the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Tuesday.

## DOUBLE DUTCH

- **Matt Duchene** enters tonight's game having totaled 21 points (10-11—21) in 17 games this season, which includes recording seven multi-point efforts this year.
- With 21 points in 17 games, **Duchene** has already reached 32.3 percent of his total scoring from last year (25-40—65) despite only being 20.7 percent of the way through the 2024-25 season.
- **Duchene** has recorded a point in 12 of the 17 games he has played this season and enters tonight's game leading the Stars in both goals (10) and points (21) and ranks second on the team in assists (11).
- When **Duchene** has been on the ice this season during 5-on-5 play, the Stars have outscored their opponents 14-7 according to Natural Stat Trick.
- He is currently pacing to finish the year with 48 goals, 53 assists and 101 points, which would all be career highs for the 16-year veteran.

## ROOKIE REPORT

- **Logan Stankoven** has 14 points (4-10—14) through his first 17 games played this season and enters tonight's game tied ranked fourth on the team in scoring.
- Entering play Tuesday, **Stankoven** ranked second among all rookies in assists, points and points per game (0.88) this season among rookies to play in at least three games this year.
  - His four goals tied for third among first-year players this season entering play Tuesday.
- Three of **Stankoven's** goals this season have been game-winners, which led the Stars and topped all NHL rookies entering play Tuesday. Only Minnesota's Matt Boldy (5) and Edmonton's Leon Draisaitl (4) have scored more game-winning goals than **Stankoven** this year.
- **Stankoven's** goal against the Bruins in Dallas' game on Nov. 14 was his 14th point of the season. His 14 points are tied with Danny Grant (10-4—14 in 1968-69) for the third most through 15 games in a season by a Stars/North Stars rookie behind only Neal Broten (10-7—17 in 1981-82) and Steve Christoff (8-7—15 in 1979-80) according to NHL Stats.
- **Stankoven** recorded his 10th assist of the season (12 GP) in Dallas' game on Nov. 7 against Chicago, establishing a franchise mark for fewest games to 10 helpers in a season by a Stars/North Stars rookie according to NHL Stats. The previous mark of 14 games was shared by Don Barber (1989-90 w/ MNS), Tim Young (1975-76 w/ MNS) and Danny O'Shea (1968-69 w/ MNS).
- **Stankoven** (8-18—26 in 36 GP) added an empty-net goal against Chicago to become the second-fastest player in Stars team history to record 25 career points, following **Jason Robertson** (33 GP) according to NHL Stats.
- With his assist on Oct. 15 against the Sharks, **Stakoven** became just the second rookie in Stars/North Stars history to record five or more assists through his first four games of a season, joining Marc Bureau (5 in 4 GP in 1990-91) according to NHL Stats.
- He recorded three assists in Dallas' 4-3 win over the Predators on Oct. 10, making him the only rookie to have a three-point game this season.
- According to NHL Stats, **Stankoven** became the second rookie in franchise history to record three points in the team's season-opening contest, alongside Roland Eriksson (0-4—4 w/ MNS) on Oct. 6, 1976.



- Originally selected by the Stars in the second round (47th overall) of the 2021 NHL Draft, **Stankoven** appeared in 24 regular-season games for Dallas last year, totaling 14 points (6-8–14) in those contests and adding eight points (3-5–8) in 19 Stanley Cup Playoff games.
- His 10 assists this season have already surpassed his total from last year and he is one point shy of surpassing his total from 2023-24.
- Despite only playing in 41 regular-season games in his career, **Stankoven** already ranks 12th in career scoring among skaters selected in the 2021 NHL Draft. His 0.70 career points per game also top 2021 draftees who have appeared in at least two regular-season games.
  - The 11 skaters ranked in front of him have all played in at least 90 career regular-season games.
- Stankoven** is pacing to finish the year with 48 assists and 68 points. Forty-eight assists would be the third-most by a rookie in franchise history and 68 points would make him the highest scoring rookie since Mathew Barzal had 85 points (22-63–85) in 2017-18.

## BENN THERE DONE THAT

- Stars captain **Jamie Benn** enters tonight's contest having played in 314 consecutive games.
- Dallas' Oct. 13 matchup against the Kraken marked the 300th consecutive game that **Benn** had played in, making him the fourth player in franchise history to play in 300 consecutive games for the team according to NHL Stats.
- He is one game shy of matching **Tyler Seguin** for the second-longest Iron Man streak in franchise history.

- Benn's** current 314-game Iron Man streak is the fifth-longest active streak in the NHL.
- Benn** is one of 18 players to have an active Iron Man streak of at least 200 games and is one of 11 NHL players to appear in each of his team's 246 regular-season games between 2021-22 and 2023-24.
- The Stars captain leads all Dallas players in career games played (1,129), goals (386), assists (530) and points (916). His 916 career points rank 13th among active NHL skaters, and he is the second-highest scoring fifth-round draft pick in NHL history (Alexander Mogilny; 1,032).

## ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- Jake Oettinger's** next shutout will be the 12th of his career, which will tie Jon Casey for the sixth-most in franchise history.
- Miro Heiskanen** is seven assists shy of tying Dennis Hextall (216) for 23rd on the franchise's all-time assists list. He's also eight assists shy of trying Brad Maxwell (217) for 7th on the all-time assists list by defensemen.
- Matt Duchene** is 14 points away from recording his 100th point with the Stars.
- Esa Lindell** is 14 games shy of tying Lou Nanne (635) for ninth on the franchise's all-time games played list by defensemen.

## CONNECTIONS

- Stars forward **Oskar Bäck** and defenseman **Nils Lundkvist** both played for Sweden with Sharks forward Fabian Zetterlund at the 2019 IIHF World Junior Championship.
- Stars forward **Colin Blackwell** and Sharks forward **Alex Wennberg** were both a part of the Seattle Kraken's inaugural roster in 2021-22. **Blackwell** was the team's expansion selection from the Rangers and **Wennberg** signed with the team as a free agent.
- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** played in Pittsburgh with Sharks defenseman Cody Ceci (2020-21), forward Mikael Granlund (2022-23) and defenseman Jan Rutta (2022-23).
- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** and Sharks defenseman Henry Thrun both played for Team USA at the 2023 IIHF World Championship.
- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** and Sharks forward Logan Couture won a gold medal together while playing for Team Canada at the 2016 World Cup of Hockey.
- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** played in Nashville with Sharks forward Mikael Granlund (2019-20 to 2022-23) and with Sharks defenseman Matt Benning (2020-21 to 2021-22). Stars forward **Colin Blackwell** also played in Nashville with Granlund for parts of the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons.
- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** played in Ottawa with Sharks defenseman Cody Ceci from 2017-18 to 2018-19.
- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** and Sharks forward Alex Wennberg both played for the Blue Jackets in 2018-19.
- Stars forwards **Matt Duchene** and **Tyler Seguin** won a gold medal with Sharks forward Tyler Toffoli and Sharks defenseman Cody Ceci while playing for Canada at the 2015 IIHF World Championship. Jim Nill was the general manager of the team and Pete DeBoer (assistant coach) and Misha Donskov (video coach) were both on Canada's coaching staff.
- Stars defenseman **Matt Dumba** played in Minnesota with Sharks forwards Mikael Granlund (2013-14 to 2018-19) and Nico Strum (2018-19 to 2021-22).

- Stars forward **Miro Heiskanen** and Sharks forward Mikael Granlund played for Finland together at both the 2018 and 2022 IIHF World Championships, winning a gold medal in 2022.
- Stars defenseman **Esa Lindell** and Sharks forward Mikael Granlund have represented Finland in international competition together three times – at the 2016 and 2022 IIHF World Championships and at the 2016 World Cup of Hockey. They medaled at both World Championships, winning silver in 2016 and gold in 2022.
- Stars defenseman **Nils Lundkvist** and Sharks forward Barclay Goodrow both played for the Rangers during the 2021-22 season.
- Stars forward **Mason Marchment** played part of the 2019-20 season in Toronto with Sharks defenseman Cody Ceci.
- Stars forward **Mason Marchment** and Sharks forward Alex Wennberg both played for the Florida Panthers in 2020-21.
- Stars goaltender **Jake Oettinger** won a gold medal with Sharks forward Luke Kunin while the two played for Team USA at the 2017 IIHF World Junior Championship.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** played in New Jersey with Sharks forwards Tyler Toffoli (2023-24) and Fabian Zetterlund (2022-23) and goaltenders Mackenzie Blackwood (2022-23) and Vitek Vanecek (2022-23 to 2023-24).
