## BLUE JACKETS TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus fell to 2-2-1 in its last five home games of the campaign.
- ★ CBJ moved to 18-10-2 vs. Dallas since 2012-13 season and 2-4-0 in the last six meetings after Dallas swept the season series (5-3 at Dallas on Oct. 30).
- ★ Columbus failed to register a point for just the fourth time in the last 16 meetings in the series at Nationwide Arena dating back to January 28, 2013 (10-4-2).
- ★ The winning team has scored four or more goals in each of the past three meetings and six of the past eight since April 15, 2021.
- ★ The Blue Jackets killed off both of the Stars' power play opportunities tonight and have now killed off all 15 Dallas power play chances over the last ten meetings dating back to March 13, 2021 and 21-of-22 chances over the past 12 dating back to March 4, 2021.
- ★ CBJ have killed off all 15 opponent power play opportunities over the past six contests and 27-of-29 chances over the last ten games (93.1 pct.).
- ★ Columbus has scored the first goal in six of the past ten games after scoring the first goal of the contest 1:08 in. It was the fastest CBJ goal to start a game this season.
- ★ The Blue Jackets played their fourth (1-2-1) of 16 Thursday games this season.

## BLUE JACKETS PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Boone Jenner** notched a goal for the third time in the last four contests (3-1-4) with his seventh of the campaign. He leads the club in goals and points (tied) with 7-2-9 in 13 games this season. He now ranks third on the franchise's all-time list for most points with 177-161-338 in 670 games.
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** scored for the second-straight game and third time in the last four with a first period tally. He also set a new career high with points in four consecutive outings (3-1-4).

- ★ LW **Johnny Gaudreau** notched his fifth assist of the season to give him 1-5-6 in 13 games. He improved to 10-9-19 in 23 career games vs. the Stars.
- ★ LW **Dmitri Voronkov** registered an assist, giving him points in five of his first seven NHL games (2-3-5).
- ★ C **Adam Fantilli** notched an assist and now has 2-5-7 in 13 games.
- ★ RW **Jack Roslovic** registered an assist, giving him 2-6-8 in 12 games this season. He improved to 2-12-14 in 22 career games vs. the Stars, including 1-10-11 in 10 career games at home.
