THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Dallas' next win will mark the 618th victory of Pete DeBoer's head coaching career, which will give him sole possession
 of 21st on the all-time coaching wins list. His 617 career wins are currently tied with Bruce Boudreau and Jacques
 Lemaire.
- The Stars have allowed only 1.86 goals against per game this season, which was the third-best mark in the NHL entering
 play Wednesday.
- Esa Lindell has registered a team-leading 20 blocked shots this season, which was tied for the seventh-most in the NHL entering play Wednesday.
- Jamie Benn has 11 points (4-7—11) in 10 career road games against the Bruins.
- Jason Robertson has five points (1-3—5) in five career games against Boston.
- A win tonight would give the Stars their first road victory against the Bruins since Jan. 15, 2018.

MILESTONE MEN

- Stars forwards Roope Hintz and Jason Robertson are both set to reach new career milestones tonight against the Bruins - Hintz is expected to play in his 400th NHL game and Robertson in his 300th.
- Hintz, originally selected by Dallas in the second round (49th overall) of the 2015 NHL Draft, is set to become the 30th skater from his draft class to reach the 400-game milestone.
 - o His 317 career points (150-167—317) rank 12th among 2015 draft picks.
- Hintz will also become the 42nd player in franchise history to appear in 400 games with the team.
- Originally selected by the Stars in the second round (39th overall) of the 2017 NHL Draft, Robertson will become the 74th player to appear in 300 games for the club.

- Despite becoming the 17th player from the 2017 draft class to skate in 30 NHL game, Roberston's 319 career points (136-183-319) rank fifth among his draft class.
 - o Robertson's 1.07 career points per game rank second to only Cale Makar (1.09) among 2017 draft picks.

KILLING IT

- The Stars have gone 21-for-22 on the penalty kill this season for a 95.5 percent success rate, which was the best mark in the league entering play Wednesday and makes them the only team with a penalty kill rate above 90 percent.
- Dallas has gone six consecutive games without allowing a power-play goal against. If they were to remain perfect on the penalty kill tonight, it would mark the first time since Jan. 30 to Feb. 18, 2022 that the team has gone seven consecutive games without surrendering a power-play goal.
- With Colin Blackwell's shorthanded goal against the Capitals on Oct. 17, the Stars now have an even goal differential while playing shorthanded this season. Entering play Wednesday, Dallas and Washington were the only two teams this season to have an even goal differential on the penalty kill.

JAKE FROM THE DALLAS STARS

- Goaltender Jake Oettinger has gone 4-1-0 in five games played this season. Entering play Wednesday, his four wins
 were tied for the second-most in the league this year.
- **Oettinger** has recorded a .941 save percentage and 1.81 goals-against average this year, which were tied for fourth and ranked fifth, respectively, among goaltenders to play four games this season entering play Wednesday.
- Through four games played this season, **Oettinger** has saved 6.1 goals above expected according to MoneyPuck.com, which was tied for third the NHL entering play Wednesday.
- Oettinger signed an eight-year, \$66 million contract extension with Dallas on Oct. 17. His new deal will kick in next year and will run through the 2032-33 season.
- Since the 2020-21 NHL season, **Oettinger** ranks in the top 10 in wins (117, sixth) and goals-against average (2.49, seventh) amongst active goalies to play in at least 50 regular-season games. He also tied for 11th in save percentage (.914) and tied for 13th in shutouts (11) over that span.
- Over the last three postseasons, his 23 wins in the Stanley Cup Playoffs are tied with Igor Shesterkin for the secondmost by any netminder.
- Despite only being five seasons into his NHL career, Oettinger ranks in the top 10 in franchise history in wins (117, eighth), save percentage (.914, fourth), goals-against average (2.49, fifth) and shutouts (11, seventh) amongst franchise netminders.

M&M

- When forwards Matt Duchene and Mason Marchment have been on the ice during 5-on-5 play this season, the Stars have outscored their opponents 3-1 and have 18 high-danger scoring chances for compared to their opponents' seven according to Natural Stat Trick.
- Marchment has assisted on two of Duchene's three goals this season, and in turn Duchene assisted on one of Marchment's two tallies.
- With six points each, **Duchene** (3-2-6) and **Marchment** (2-4-6) enter tonight's game tied for third on the team in scoring.

ROOKIE REPORT

- Logan Stankoven has recorded seven assists through the Stars' first seven games of the season and was leading all NHL rookies is scoring entering play Wednesday.
- His seven assists were tied for the seventh-most in the NHL entering play Wednesday and also tied him with Roope Hintz for the team lead in scoring this season.
- With his assist on Oct. 15 against the Sharks, **Stakoven** became just the second rookie in Stars/North Stars history to record five or more assists through his first four games of a season, joining Marc Bureau (5 in 4 GP in 1990-91) according to NHL Stats.
- He recorded three assists in Dallas' 4-3 win over the Predators on Oct. 10, making him the only rookie to have a three-point game this season.
- According to NHL Stats, Stankoven became the second rookie in franchise history to record three points in the team's season-opening contest, alongside Roland Eriksson (0-4—4 w/ MNS) on Oct. 6, 1976.
- Originally selected by the Stars in the second round (47th overall) of the 2021 NHL Draft, Stankoven appeared in 24 regular-season games for Dallas last year, totaling 14 points (6-8—14) in those contests and adding eight points (3-5—8) in 19 Stanley Cup Playoff games.

FROM START TO FINNISH

- Forward Roope Hitz was named one of the Stars alternate captains this season. 2024-25 will mark the first time that Hitz and fellow Fins Miro Heiskanen and Esa Lindell are all a part of Dallas' leadership group.
 - o Captain Jamie Benn and alternate captain Tyler Seguin round out the team's leadership group for this season.

- Heiskanen, Hintz and Lindell are three of six Finnish players in the NHL this season to be a part of their team's leadership
 group, joining Florida captain Aleksander Barkov, Carolina alternate Sebastian Aho and Colorado alternate Mikko
 Rantanen.
- Heiskanen, Hintz and Lindell are set to face off against Barkov the NHL's Global Series when the Stars will take on the Panthers in back-to-back games on Nov. 1 and 2 at Nokia Arena in Tampere, Finland.
- All three of Heiskanen, Hintz and Lindell rank in the top 15 in all-time scoring among active, Finnish skaters. At eighth, Hintz ranks the highest with 317 career points followed by Heiskanen (258, 10th) and Lindell (191, 13th).

BENN THERE DONE THAT

- Stars captain Jamie Benn enters tonight's contest having played in 304 consecutive games.
- Dallas' Oct. 13 matchup against the Kraken marked the 300th consecutive game that Benn had played in, making him
 the fourth player in franchise history to play in 300 consecutive games for the team according to NHL Stats.

- Benn's current 304-game Iron Man streak is the fifth-longest active streak in the NHL.
- Benn is one of 16 players to have an active Iron Man streak of at least 200 games and is one of 11 NHL players to appear in each of his team's 246 regular-season games between 2021-22 and 2023-24.
- The Stars captain leads all Dallas players in career games played (1,119), goals (384), assists (525) and points (909). His 909 career points rank 12th among active NHL skaters, and he is the second-highest scoring fifth-round draft pick in NHL history (Alexander Mogilny; 1,032).

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- Tyler Seguin is seven assists away from bringing his total with the stars to 380, which would tie him with Brian Bellows for fifth-most assists by a skater in franchise history.
- Esa Lindell is nine points shy of becoming the 49th player and 13th defenseman in franchise history to record 200 points with the Stars. He is also just three goals away from tying Philippe Boucher (52) for the 10th-most goals among defensemen in franchise history.
- Jake Oettinger's next shutout will be the 12th of his career, which will tie Jon Casey for the sixth-most in franchise history.

FOR PETE'S SAKE

- Dallas' win over the Predators on Oct. 10 marked Head Coach **Pete DeBoer's** 100th behind the Stars bench. He became the fourth Stars head coach (since 1993-94) to record at least 100 regular-season wins with the team, joining Ken Hitchcock (319), Dave Tippett (271) and Lindy Ruff (165).
- Since the start of the 2022-23 season **DeBoer's** first as the team's head coach the Stars have posted a 104-44-23 record for a .675 win percentage, which is the fourth-best mark in the NHL during that span.
 - Only Jim Montgomery (Boston; 115) and Rod Brind'Amour (Carolina; 107) have recorded more regular-season wins since the starts of the 2022-23 season
- DeBoer has posted a 617-423-146 record over the course of his coaching career with the Dallas Stars, Vegas Golden Knights (2019-20 to 2021-22), San Jose Sharks (2015-16 to 2019-20), New Jersey Devils (2011-12 to 2014-15) and Florida Panthers (2008-19 to 2010-11). His 617 career wins are tied for 21st all-time among all NHL coaches and rank fifth all-time among active coaches.
