TEAM NOTES

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are set to take on the Nashville Predators tonight at Bridgestone Arena in the second of two games between the clubs this season. The Maple Leafs won their first game of the season against Nashville in a 3-2 final on December 4th at Scotiabank Arena. The Maple Leafs posted a 1-0-1 record against Nashville during the 2023-24 season while posting a 6-3-1 record through their last 10 meetings. The team is skating in their second game of a two-game road trip (1-0-0). The club has posted a 20-11-2 record on the road this season. Entering tonight's matchup the club has won three-consecutive games.

LAST GAME

● The Maple Leafs won 4-3 against the New York Rangers on Thursday night at Madison Square Garden. John Tavares scored twice and added an assist in Toronto's win. With his second goal (and third point) of the game, Tavares posted the 1,100th point of his NHL career. Tavares became the 68th player in NHL history (and eighth active player) to reach the 1,100-point mark. Bobby McMann and Matthew Knies (GWG) also added a goal each. William Nylander added two assists for Toronto. With his first assist of the game, Nylander recorded the 600th point of his NHL career becoming the ninth player in franchise history to reach the 600-point mark. With three assists, Jake McCabe set a new single-game NHL career-high in assists and tied a single-game NHL career-high in points. Anthony Stolarz stopped 27 of 30 shots he faced in Thursday's win.
