AT A GLANCE

TREVOR'S THOUSAND

Forward **Trevor Lewis** skated in his 1,000th career NHL game on Saturday vs. Tampa Bay, becoming the 13th skater selected in the 2006 NHL Draft to reach such mark and the first Utah-born skater in league history to skate in 1,000 games. The two-time Stanley Cup Champion (2012, 2014) also became the 26th skater to play their 1,000th career game as a member of the LA Kings, and the second U.S.-born player to do so after **Dustin Brown**.

BATTLE OF THE BULLDOGS

Tonight's game at Canada Life Centre will feature a quartet of University of Minnesota-Duluth alumni, including Kings defenseman **Mikey Anderson** (2017-19) and Winnipeg skaters **Dylan Samberg** (2017-20), **Neal Pionk** (2015-2017) and former LA King **Alex Iafallo** (2013-2017). During their collegiate years 375 miles from the site of tonight's game, Anderson's defensive partner was Samberg.

KEEPERS OF THE CASTLE

The Kings near the midpoint of the campaign having allowed just 95 goals through their first 38 games. Across the NHL, the Kings have the fewest goals against overall, the fewest goals against in the first period (22), and the fewest goals-against-per game (2.50). Among all League clubs, the Kings are joined by the Dallas Stars (99 GA, 39 GP) as the only two teams to have conceded fewer than 100 goals against at this stage of the campaign.

PHILLING UP THE NET

Phillip Danault notched his 18th helper on the year last Saturday night. In doing so, Danault extended his assist streak (0-6=6) to a career-long six games. Danault's current assist streak is also one of four different point streaks of at least six games he has established in his career. Danault has five points (2-3=5) over his past four contests against the Winnipeg Jets, including the game-winning tally in the two clubs' previous meeting this season on Nov. 27.
