AT A GLANCE

HOME SWEET HOME

Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** leads the team in assists with 10 and sits second in points with 11 (1-10=11), trailing only **Anze Kopitar** (4-8=12). Clarke carries a four-game point streak (1-6=7) into this afternoon's contest, including his second three-plus point game of the season – and career – Wednesday night against the Golden Knights. Clarke is one of five blueliners in team history to record multiple three-plus point games before turning 22 years of age. Clarke has now notched 11 points through the team's first 11 games of the season, becoming the third defenseman in Kings history aged 21 years or younger to record as many points through the teams' first 11 games, joining **Larry Murphy** 2x, 4-7=11 in 1980-81 and 5-8=13 in 1981-82) and **Rob Blake** (2-11=13 in 1990-91).

WE'RE GOING STREAKIN'

The Kings skate into tomorrow's matinee riding a 10-game point streak against the Blackhawks (8-0-2), dating back to Nov. 2, 2019. It is the longest active point streaks against any one opponent for the Kings, and one of five of at least seven games in length. Should the team collect a point tonight, it would mark the eighth different point streak of at least 11 games against any one opponent in franchise history. In their last 20 outings vs. Chicago dating back to the 2016-17 season, the Kings have accumulated a record of 15-3-2 with 32 points and an .800 PTS % and have been held pointless in just three of those 20 matchups. The team's .800 PTS % against the Blackhawks rank sixth-highest, and third-highest among Western Conference teams, in that span (min. GP: 10).

1-800-CAPTAIN

Anze Kopitar skates into Crypto.com Arena fresh off recording his 800th career assist as part of the 304th multi-point game of his career (1-2=3) Wednesday night against the Golden Knights. By doing so, Kopitar became the 35th skater in league history to reach such milestone and just the fifth player born and trained outside of North America to reach the milestone: **Jaromir Jagr** (1,155), **Evgeni Malkin** (809), **Nicklas Lidstrom** (878) and **Henrik Sedin** (830). The captain also joins **Sidney Crosby** (1,013), **Patrick Kane** (818) and Malkin (809) as the only active skaters to have hit the 800-assist mark in their careers.
