KINGS NOTES

- Winger **Trevor Moore** (1-0=1) scored his second goal of the season, extending his goal streak against the Hurricanes to a fifth game (6-0=6), dating back to Oct. 14, 2023. Moore joins **Bernie Nicholls** (6GP; 8-6=14) and **Marcel Dionne** (7GP; 9-1=10) as the only skaters in LA Kings history to record a goal streak of five or more games against the Hurricanes/Whalers franchise.
- Moore is the first skater in Kings history to record such a streak since the Hurricanes relocated from Hartford, Conn. to Raleigh, N.C..
- The Thousand Oaks, Calif., native also joins **Peter Stastny** (5GP; 6-7=13), **Dino Ciccarelli** (6GP; 8-2=10), **Martin St. Louis** (6GP; 8-3=11) and **Jeff Halpern** (7GP; 7-2=9) as the only undrafted skaters in League history to post a goal streak of five or more games against the Hurricanes franchise. Moore recorded his 205th career point and passed **Alex Iafallo** and **Eddie Joyal** for the seventh most by an undrafted player in a Kings uniform, per NHL PR.
- Winger **Andrei Kuzmenko** (1-0=1) scored the Kings' second goal of the second period, his second power play goal in as many games played this week. The tally marks Kuzmenko's fifth career point against Carolina (2-3=5).
- Forward **Kevin Fiala** (1-0=1) tied the game at three goals apiece with his team-leading fourth goal of the season, his third consecutive game finding the back of the net. The Swiss winger has tallied 15 points (7-8=15) in 17 career matchups with the Hurricanes and has a three-game goal and point streak (4-1=5) against the club from the Tarheel State, dating back to Feb. 1, 2025.
- Center **Quinton Byfield** (0-1=1) notched his fourth assist of the season, extending his point and assist streaks to a third game (1-3=4) dating back to Oct. 13. Byfield also extends his assist and point streak against the Hurricanes to a third game (1-4=5) dating back to Feb. 1, 2025.
- Winger **Adrian Kempe** (0-2=2) picked up his fourth and fifth assists of the season, extending his home point streak against the Hurricanes to a third game (1-3=4) dating back to Oct. 14, 2023. Kempe joins **Tomas Sandstrom** (3GP, 3-2=5) as the only Swedish skaters in franchise history to record a three-game home point streak against the Hurricanes.
- Forward **Phillip Danault** (0-1=1) recorded his first helper on home ice this season, extending his point streak against the Hurricanes to four games (2-5=7).
- Defenseman **Joel Edmundson** tallied his first point of the season (0-1=1) with his 96th career assist. Edmundson, who played for the Hurricanes in the 2019-20 season, posts his third career point (1-2=3) against Carolina.
- Forward **Jeff Malott** registered a career-best six hits tonight, surpassing his previous career high of four set on April 14, 2025 at Edmonton.
- Goaltender **Anton Forsberg** appeared in his third game as a member of the Kings, his 193rd career regular season appearance. Forsberg's 193 career games played breaks a tie with **Eddie Mio** (192GP; 124th overall, 1974) for sole possession of the eighth most games played by a goaltender drafted in the seventh round in League history.
