AT A GLANCE

HOW SWEDE IT IS

Forward **Adrian Kempe** scored his sixth and seventh goals of the campaign as part of his team-leading seventh multi-point performance of the season on Wednesday night at Ball Arena. Kempe's 16 points (7-9=16) are the second most on the Kings through the first 18 games of the season, trailing only Anze Kopitar (5-15=20). In his past six outings against the Red Wings, Kempe has registered five goals and seven points (5-2=7), dating back to Jan. 8, 2022. The speedy winger gears up for tonight's matchup at Crypto.com Arena with goals in three straight home games against the Original Six club.

THOUSAND OAKS, HUNDRED APPLES

Thousand Oaks, Calif. native **Trevor Moore** returns to Crypto.com Arena on a career-long seven-game point streak (2-7=9) after recording his 38th career multipoint game (0-2=2) on Wednesday in Colorado. Moore's pair of helpers marked his 99th and 100th assists as a member of the Kings, making him the 12th undrafted skater to record 100 helpers for the franchise. In doing so, Moore became just the eighth American-born skater in team history to record 100 assists in a Kings uniform. Last Saturday against the Blue Jackets, Moore potted the 11th shorthanded goal of his career to surpass **Ziggy Palffy** for sole possession of the seventh-most in team history. Since making his Kings debut on Feb. 8, 2020, Moore's 11 shorthanded goals is tied with Kempe and paces both Kings and League skaters alike.

KOPITAR V. KANE: XLIX

Forward **Anze Kopitar** will take the ice against familiar foe **Patrick Kane** and the Detroit Red Wings with nine points (3-6=9) and a game-winning goal in his last six appearances against the franchise, dating back to March 15, 2018. Tonight's game will be the 49th occasion that the two future Hall-of-Famers have matched up against one another in the regular season, with each skater's side coming away with the victory 24 times out of the previous 48 contests. Over the four-dozen games to feature Kopitar and Kane since 2007-08, the former has logged 37 points (11-26=37) and a plus-6 rating while the latter has posted 43 points (15-28=43) and a minus-4 rating.
