AT A GLANCE

HOW SWEDE IT IS

Forward **Adrian Kempe** returns to Bell Centre having found the scoresheet (3-2=5) in each of his past four trips to *La Belle Province* as a member of the Kings, dating back to his overtime game-winner just over four years ago today, Nov. 9, 2021. That deciding marker is the most recent of his three game-winning goals in the building, tied for the most as a visitor to Bell Centre by any active skater in the NHL. Of the six players with as many game-winners in Montreal, Kempe (7 GP) is the only one to do so in fewer than 10 opportunities. Overall, tomorrow's contest is the Kramfors, Sweden, native's first visit to the building since he swapped the Kings' crown for the *Tre Kronor* to represent his homeland at the 4 Nations Face-Off this past February. Kempe helped Team Sweden mount a comeback attempt against their Canadian hosts with an early third-period tally at Bell Centre on Feb. 12, 2025.

ELEVEN ELEVEN


Captain **Anze Kopitar** skates into Montreal with a power play goal in each of his past two games, dating back to Nov. 6 against Florida, one of three streaks he carries into *la ville*. Beginning with a three-assist night on Dec. 17, 2023, Kopitar has found the scoresheet (0-5=5) in three straight games against the Canadiens, while that three-point night also counted toward a separate three-game point streak (1-4=5) at Bell Centre that began on Dec. 10, 2022. Overall, Kopitar has accumulated 24 points (9-15=24) in 26 meetings with the Montreal Canadiens.

WE SURVEYED ONE HUNDRED

Forward **Quinton Byfield** skates into Montreal averaging a pair of points per game (2-2=4) through his first two road games against the Canadiens. Fueled by two separate three-point performances (2-1=3; Dec. 7, 2023, and 0-3=3; Feb. 5, 2025), Byfield has a three-game point streak (2-5=7) against the Original Six organization, dating back to Dec. 7, 2023. In total, the 23-year-old has eight points (2-6=8) in five career games played against the *bleu*, *blanc*, *et rouge*, tied with Sherbrooke, Quebec, native **Yanic Perreault** (4-4=8; Oct. 23, 1995 – Nov. 8, 1997) for the most points by a Kings skater through their first five career games versus Montreal in team history.
