PICK IS IT

Owen Pickering, who was drafted 21st overall by the Penguins in 2022, made his NHL debut on Saturday night against San Jose, earning his first NHL point with an assist on Jesse Puljujarvi's goal in 13:20 minutes of ice time.

- Pickering became the eighth defenseman and 31st total player to make his NHL debut this season. Among all rookies to make their debut in 2024-25, Pickering was the first defenseman and sixth skater to record a point in his debut:

- Pickering became the 16th defenseman and 54th player in Penguins history to record his first career point in his NHL debut.
- Pickering is the first defenseman to record a point in his NHL debut since P.O Joseph did so on January 22, 2021 and is just the seventh blueliner to do so in the past 30 years:

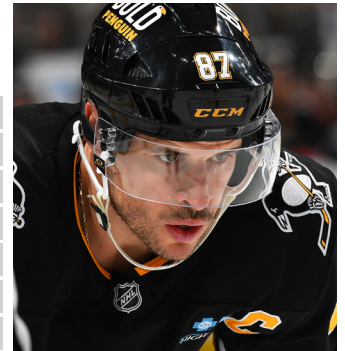
Sidney Crosby enters tonight's game just one goal away from becoming the 21st player in NHL history to score 600 career goals.

- He will become just the seventh player in NHL history to score 600 career goals with one team:

Anthony Beauvillier recorded an assist on Sidney Crosby's goal on Saturday night against San Jose to extend his point streak to four games.

- Beauvillier has recorded three goals, two assists and five points during his four-game point streak.
