KINGS NOTES

- Forward **Adrian Kempe** (1-0=1) scored his third goal of the season. The winger has now recorded 20 points (9-11=20) in his last 13 games against the Anaheim Ducks, dating back to May 21st, 2021.
- Second-year winger **Alex Laferrriere** (1-0=1) registered his fourth goal of the season, marking the first time in his career that he has scored back-to-back game-winning goals.
- Forward **Kevin Fiala** (1-0=1) recorded his seventh goal in as many Freeway Faceoff appearances, and now has 10 points (7-3=10) in seven games against the Kings' Pacific Division rivals since joining the team ahead of the 2022-23 season.
- Defenseman **Mikey Anderson** (1-1=2) registered his second goal and second assist of the season. With his goal, Anderson became the third Kings defenseman since 2019-20 to score in consecutive games, following **Drew Doughty** (7x) and **Sean Walker** (2019-20), per NHL PR.
- Forward **Phillip Danault** (0-1=1) picked up his second helper of the campaign.
- Forward **Anze Kopitar** (0-1=1) provided the primary assist on Kempe's opening tally and has now recorded 1,219 points in his career (422-797=1,219), tied with **Jean Beliveau** (507-712=1,219) for 45th in NHL history.
- Kopitar now sits three assists away from reaching the 800-assist plateau.
- Defenseman **Vladislav Gavrikov** (0-1=1) collected his third assist of the season, establishing an assist streak of two-games or longer for the tenth time in his career and the first time as a member of the Kings.
- Forward **Alex Turcotte** (0-1=1) registered an assist to further extend his career-long point streak to a fourth game (1-3=4).
- Goaltender **David Rittich** turned aside 14 of the Ducks' 15 shots on goal at Honda Center as the Kings played their first Western Conference opponent of the regular season.
