COOL YOUR JETS

Since the team has been in Winnipeg beginning in the 2011-12 season, the Penguins have gone 20-8-0 against them, outscoring the Jets by a 98-71 margin.

- Evgeni Malkin has been a leading contributor to the Penguins' success against the Jets. The forward has 20 goals, 33 assists and 53 points in 41 games against Winnipeg in his career.
- Malkin's 53 points are the sixth most against Winnipeg among all active players:

JARRY VS. WPG

Tristan Jarry has been stellar against the Winnipeg Jets in his career, going 5-1-0 with a 1.16 goals-against average, .960 save percentage and two shutouts.

- Jarry's goals-against average and save percentage against the Jets are the second and third best in NHL history (min. 5 GP), respectively:

600 WATCH

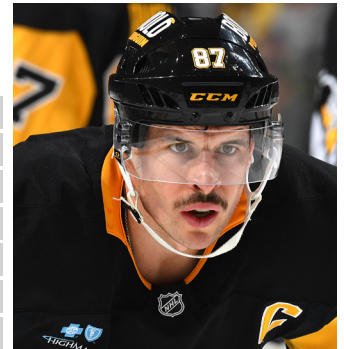
Sidney Crosby enters tonight's game just one goal away from becoming the 21st player in NHL history to score 600 career goals.

- Crosby is set to join Mario Lemieux (690) as the only two Penguins to score 600 goals with the franchise.
- He will become just the seventh player in NHL history to score 600 career goals with one team:

Head Coach Mike Sullivan enters tonight's game with 499 career wins in the regular season and playoffs split between the Penguins and Boston Bruins.

- Tonight will be Sullivan's 946th career game and he is set to become the fastest U.S.-born head coach in NHL history to reach 500 wins in the regular season and playoffs:

SLICKY RICKY

Rickard Rakell scored his team-leading (tied) seventh goal of the season on Tuesday night against Tampa Bay.

- Rakell's tally was his first power-play goal of the season. Since the Penguins acquired Rakell on March 21, 2022, only Sidney Crosby and Evgeni Malkin have scored more power-play goals than Rakell:
