### AT A GLANCE

#### WELCOME BACK, CAP!

Captain **Anze Kopitar** returned to the lineup Saturday afternoon at Xfinity Mobile Center, logging 16:13 minutes of time-on-ice (TOI) and winning 10 of 14 faceoffs in the Kings' 3-2 overtime victory against the Metropolitan Division's Flyers. The captain gears up for Sunday's matinee against the Carolina Hurricanes for his first contest with the club since his multi-point effort (1-1=2) on March 22, 2025. Kopitar has posted three separate multi-point performances (also 2-0=2 on Oct. 14, 2023, and 1-2=3 on Jan. 31, 2023) in his last five head-to-heads against the Hurricanes, part of his 23 points (12-11=23) in 27 career games played against the franchise from the Tar Heel State.

#### SWEDE CAROLINE

Forward **Adrian Kempe** skates into Raleigh riding a six-game point streak (5-3=8), dating back to Saturday, Jan. 17, in Anaheim, which is tied for the third-longest such streak in his career. He also carries an active six-game road point streak (4-4=8), dating back to Jan. 10 in Edmonton. The 29-year-old's current run is tied for the second-longest road point streak of his career following his seven-game stretch established earlier this season (5-6=11; Oct. 11-28, 2025). Kempe scored his 19th and 20th goals of the campaign in the first period of the Kings' win in Philadelphia to surpass **Kevin Fiala** (18 G) for the most on the team this season. Kempe then provided the primary set-up on **Quinton Byfield**'s overtime game-winner to notch his 24th assist of the year. Kempe's team-leading ninth multi-point effort of the campaign secured his fifth consecutive 20-goal season, dating to 2021-22, tied for the seventh-longest streak in franchise history, per NHL PR.
