

APPLE PICKING

Sidney Crosby has points in 10 of his last 12 games, recording 11 points (2G-9A) in the span dating back to November 13.

Crosby leads all active players with 1,023 career assists, all coming with the Penguins. He enters tonight's game one assist shy of surpassing Gordie Howe for sole possession of the fifth-most assists with one franchise in NHL history:
