AT A GLANCE

NINE SEEKS EIGHT

Forward **Adrian Kempe** returns to Crypto.com Arena riding a seven-game point streak (5-4=9), dating back to Saturday, Jan. 17, in Anaheim, which is tied for the second-longest such streak in his career. Kempe secured the seventh matchup of his current run this past Sunday in Raleigh with his team-leading 25th helper and 45th point (20-25=45) of the season. He looks to extend that streak this evening against the Seattle Kraken having recorded 13 points (6-7=13) in 16 career games against the League's second-newest franchise, the second-most among all Kings skaters behind **Kevin Fiala** (4-11=15).

RIGHT ON QUEUE

Forward **Quinton Byfield** returns to Crypto.com Arena after scoring in back-to-back games to close the Kings' road trip this past weekend. On Saturday, Jan. 31, in Philadelphia, the 6-5, 230-pound forward buried his second overtime game-winning goal of the campaign, his 10th goal of the season overall. This marked the fifth such occasion of Byfield's career, making the 23-year-old one of just nine players in Kings history with as many overtime goals; no other player in franchise history has scored more than twice in the extra frame before turning 24 years old. The next day, Feb. 1, Byfield scored his 11th goal of the year to extend his point streak against the Carolina Hurricanes to a fourth game (2-4=6), dating back exactly one year to Feb. 1, 2025. The Canadian centerman now looks to score his third goal in as many games tomorrow night against the Seattle Kraken, a club against whom he has scored twice in his last three home games, including a game-winning goal in the Kings' 2-1 victory on Nov. 23, 2024.
