

In his last five games, Jason Zucker has recorded five points (3+2), including one goal in back-to-back games.

A goal in tonight's game would give Zucker his second three-game goal streak of the season (Oct. 26 to Nov. 1).

Tage Thompson has posted five points (2+3) in his last four games, including

one assist in three consecutive games.

Bowen Byram is riding a three-game assist streak and he would earn the longest assist streak of his career with an assist in tonight's game.

In his last four games dating back to Dec. 23, Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen has a save percentage of .930, a goals-against average of 2.02 and a 3-1-0 record.

Rasmus Dahlin has recorded seven assists in his last four games.

Jack Quinn has recorded eight points (4+4) in his last seven games.

JJ Peterka has posted eight points (2+6) in his last eight games.

In his last three road contests, Jiri Kulich has tallied four points (3+1).

The Sabres are 7-6-5 all-time on January 2.

January 2, 1993: Alexander Mogilny scores his third hat trick in an 11-day span in a 7-2 win at Ottawa. Mogilny would finish the season with seven hat tricks, tying Rick Martin's franchise record set in 1975-76.

January 2, 1999: Miroslav Satan extends his goal streak to eight games to tie a franchise record with a game-winning tally in a 7-1 win at home against Calgary.

Jason Zucker has recorded one assist in backto-back games against the Avalanche and he has four points (1+3) in his last four games against Colorado.

Zach Benson has notched one point in consecutive games against the Avalanche (1+1) and a point in tonight's game would make Benson (19 years, 235 days) the youngest Sabres skater since Pierre Turgeon (18 years, 177 days) from Oct. 17, 1987 to Feb. 21, 1988 (five games; 2+3) to record a point streak of three or more games against Colorado.
