AT A GLANCE

MINN(3)S(0)TA B(0)RN

With 15 goals and 68 points (15-53=68) in 299 career NHL games, defenseman **Mikey Anderson** is set to play in his 300th career NHL game Thursday night against the Flyers. Drafted in the fourth round (103rd overall) in the 2017 NHL Draft, Anderson would become the sixth defenseman from his draft class to reach the 300-game mark, the 19th skater from his cohort to do so overall. Anderson would also be one of 11 Minnesota-Duluth (NCAA) alumni to skate in at least 300 career NHL games and one of four active alumni to accomplish such feat, behind **Justin Faulk** (933 GP), **Neal Pionk** (500 GP) and **Carson Soucy** (320 GP). The native of Roseville, Minn., enters tonight with a +5 career rating in six contests against the Flyers.

YULE LOG-GING MINUTES

On Tuesday at PPG Paints Arena, defenseman **Vladislav Gavrikov** (0-2=2) factored on both Kings goals to record both his 10th and 11th assists of the season. Gavrikov has averaged 23:43 of time-on-ice (TOI) per game and accumulated a +16 plus/minus rating, leading the Kings in the former and trailing only Adrian Kempe (+17) in the latter category through the first 31 games of the season. League-wide, Kempe is tied for the fourth highest plus/minus rating among all skaters while Gavrikov is tied for sixth—the fourth highest among all blueliners. No other NHL defenseman has accrued as high of a net plus/minus rating or higher as Gavrikov (+16) has have done so while playing as many minutes or more each night.

BROTHERLY LOVE(RTIME)

The LA Kings return to the City of Brotherly Love with points in 11 of their last 12 games against the Flyers (9-1-2) in Philadelphia, dating back to the 2009-10 season. The team's .833 points percentage (PTS %) in Philadelphia during that span ranks first in the League (min. GP: 5). Of those 12 games, seven have gone past regulation with LA taking five of the seven contests. The Kings are 7-4-2 vs. Philadelphia in overtime and 3-0 in shootouts. Six of their seven overtime wins against the Flyers overall, and two of their three shootout victories, have come at the Wells Fargo Center. Out of the last 12 games played in Philadelphia between these two teams, nine have been decided by one goal.
