TEAM NOTES

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are set to play against the San Jose Sharks tonight at SAP Center in the second of two games between the clubs this season. The Maple Leafs lost their first meeting of the season against the Sharks in a 3-2 shootout decision on March 3rd at Scotiabank Arena. Toronto posted a 2-0-0 record against San Jose during the 2023-24 season while posting a 6-2-2 record through their last 10 meetings. The Maple Leafs have earned a point in six-consecutive meetings (4-0-2) against the Sharks. Tonight begins a three-game road trip for the team, with the club posting a 20-12-2 record on the road this season. The Maple Leafs have won four of their last five games played.

LAST GAME

● The Maple Leafs won 7-2 against the Philadelphia Flyers on Tuesday night at Scotiabank Arena. John Tavares and William Nylander scored two goals each in Toronto's win with Bobby McMann, David Kämpf and Max Domi also adding a goal of their own. Tavares (2G, 2A) and Nylander (2G, 2A) each marked a four-point game. Nylander tied a single-season NHL career-high in goals with his 40th of the season. Bobby McMann scored the game-winning goal for the Maple Leafs, reaching the 20-goal mark for the first time in his NHL career. Matthew Knies posted two assists, setting a new single-season NHL career-high in assists (previously 20 in 2023-24). Anthony Stolarz stopped 17 of 19 shots he faced in Tuesday's win.
